## Series

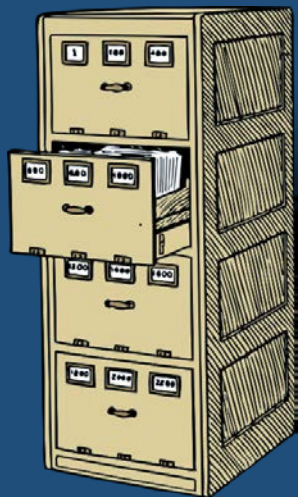
- Records with the same function or created by the same activity

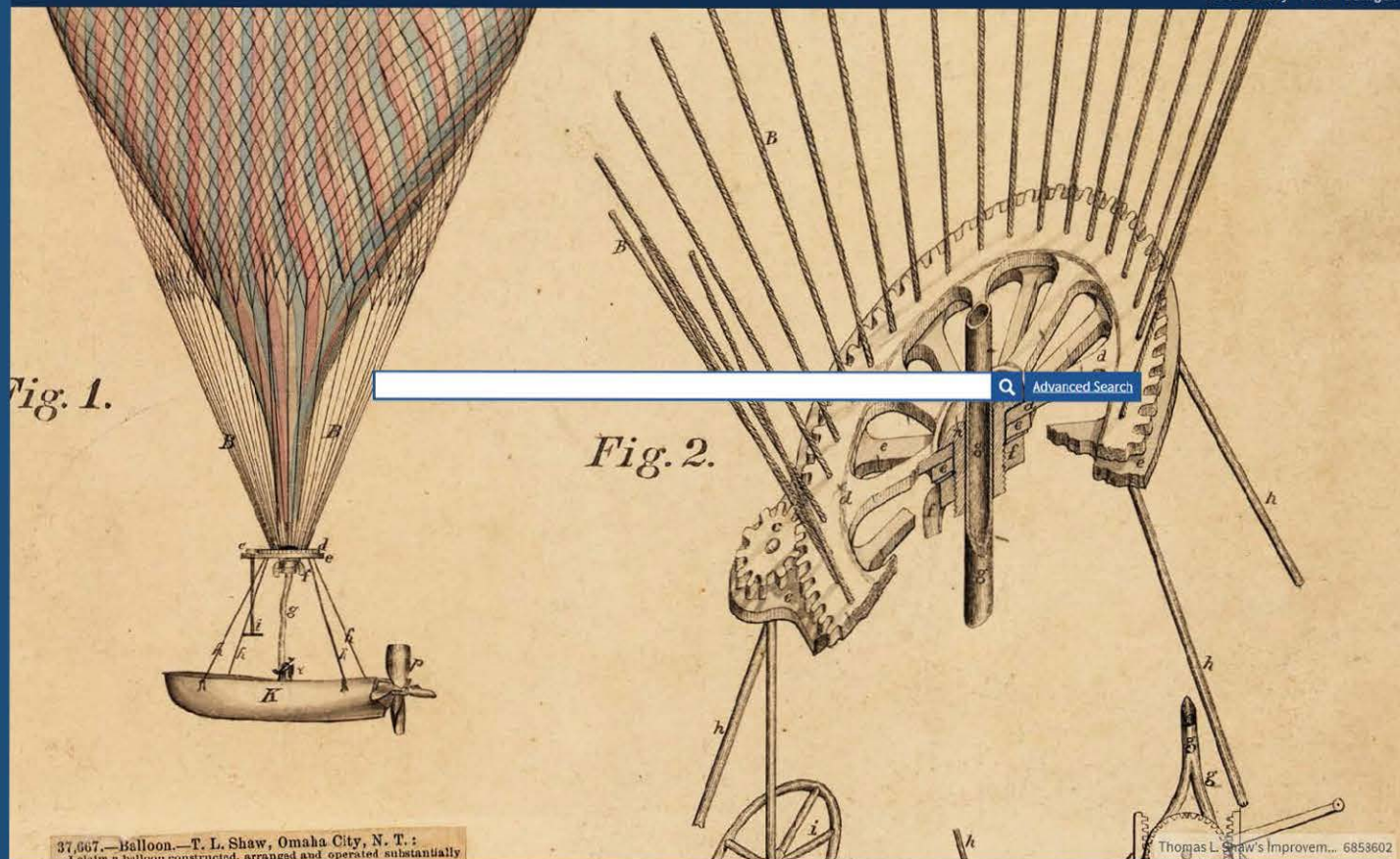

# National Archives Catalog Guide for Genealogists and Family Historians



## What is in the National Archives Catalog?

The National Archives holds historical U.S. government documents (federal, congressional, and presidential records) that are created or received by the President and his staff, by Congress, by employees of Federal government agencies, and by the Federal courts in the course of their official duties.

The National Archives Catalog contains descriptions for NARA's nationwide holdings in the Washington, DC area; regional facilities; and Presidential Libraries. The Catalog is a work in progress and currently contains descriptions for 95% of our records, described at the series level. This means you can find basic information about the records, including size and location, from the description. Additionally, every week we are adding more file unit and item descriptions, many of which include digital files.

Typically descriptions in the Catalog do not include individuals' names; however, the National Archives still might have records about your ancestors. It may be necessary to closely read records of interest to see if a particular individual is mentioned.

The Catalog contains many descriptions of records that are of interest to genealogists and family historians, including:

- Applications for enrollment in Native American tribes
- Court records
- Fugitive slave cases
- Land records
- Military personnel records
- Naturalization records
- Federal employees

## The National Archives Catalog vs. Online Genealogy Databases

- The Catalog is keyword searchable like many genealogy databases.
- You can narrow searches with filters.
- The Catalog allows you to search for records in all NARA facilities – not just selected databases.
- The current focus is on breadth of NARA's holdings (at the series level) and not individual records.
- Most Catalog descriptions do not include individual names.

# Tips for Searching for an Individual's Name

- Search on the person's full name in first name-last name order.
- Search on the surname only. The records might only include a first initial or a variant spelling of the first name.
- Search on variant spellings of the surname using OR, for example: Luchetti OR Lucetti.
- Search on variant spellings of the first name, including "Americanized" versions, for example: Joseph Maggio OR Guiseppe Maggio.
- Keep in mind that most descriptions in the National Archives Catalog do not include the names of individuals in that record. However, the National Archives still might have records about your ancestors. If you know an individual participated in an event, search for that search term and look within the records for your ancestor.

Free access to Ancestry.com and Fold3.com is available in all Research Rooms at the National Archives, including those in our regional archives and Presidential libraries. Agreements with our partners are such that there will eventually be free access online to all these digitized records through the National Archives Catalog. As microfilm publications become available in the National Archives Catalog, we will link directly to them in the Publication Title column.

Some microform publications are listed twice for the same digitization partner. For these microform publications, our partners have split the publication into separate searches on their web sites. We listed the publication twice to provide you with a direct link to each search. For example, if you click on both entries for A1154 you will see that the first entry on the list directs you to a search of "U.S. Federal Census - 1880 Schedules of Defective, Dependent, and Delinquent Classes" and the second entry on the list directs you to a search of "U.S. Federal Census Mortality Schedules, 1850-1880".

Original records that have been digitized for which there is no microfilm, will have "Original records" listed in the microfilm publication number column.

## How to Search on this Page

- To search for specific terms on this page, hold down the Control key (PC) or Command key (Mac) and push the F key.
- In the pop-up search box, type in what you are looking for. For instance, you could search on key words such as "naturalization", "passport", "passenger", "draft", "pension" or "census" to easily find these records. Then hit the arrow or "Next" button.
- Keep hitting the arrow or "Next" to find all instances of the word on the page.
- You can also sort each column by numerical or alphabetical order. The default order arranges the list in alpha-numeric order by NARA microfilm publication number.

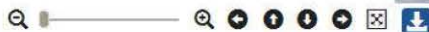

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## Commemorating D-Day

Last week the National Archives commemorated the 74th anniversary of D-Day and the Normandy Invasion. On June 6, 1944, Allied troops in World War II began their invasion of Normandy, which was part of the larger Operation Overlord. Now known as D-Day, it was the culmination of the Allied powers' strategy for the war and a multinational effort.
