IMPORTANT NOTE

The document that follows is the filing manual issued by the Department of State in 1924 to control the filing of records at American Foreign Service Posts. It is a revision and expansion of the filing manual issued in May 1912. Ultimately, the filing scheme found here covered records from the period 1912 through 1948.

For the period 1912 through 1935, except when bound into a volume with other classes or files of records deemed worthy of preservation, the preserved records generally do not include records from Class 0: Miscellaneous, Class 1: Administration, Class 2: Extradition, or File 811.11: Visas.

For the period $\underline{1936}$ through $\underline{1948}$, the following records were designated for preservation:

File 121: Diplomatic Branch

File 124: Embassies and Legations

Class 2: Extradition

Class 3: Protection of Interests

Class 4: Claims

Class 5: International Congresses and Conferences

File 631: Trade relations

In some cases records designated for preservation were mistakenly destroyed and some records designated as temporary were preserved.

INTRODUCTION

This manual is a revision and elaboration of the Diplomatic and Consular Classification of Correspondence issued May 22, 1912. It is so devised that the arrangement of the file itself serves the general purpose of a subject index. Conversely, the subject matter of a given paper determines the filing place of the paper and therefore its file number. None of the major subject headings in the first edition have been materially changed, but numerous additions and other rearrangements have been made.

Particular attention is invited to the subject of Manufactures and Manufacturing, 865. In order to care for this subject adequately, an attempt has been made to arrange the classification according to

industries.

The book will be used exactly as printed until amended by the Department. If further subdivision is necessary, it will be accomplished by alphabetical arrangement, and not by numerical addition.


This system contemplates the keeping in one place of all communications on each particular subject. In order to remove as far as possible differences of opinion as to how a piece of correspondence should be classified, the index to this book has been greatly augmented, and it is believed if carefully studied will result in correspondence on a particular subject being placed under the same number by all offices.

CLASSIFICATION


The first step in recording a communication is to determine the classification and to assign a subject number. Before attempting to classify a piece of correspondence it should be very carefully read and a conclusion reached as to the subject matter concerned. He ving reached this conclusion, the index should be referred to as a guide to the proper heading, after which the text of the classification should be examined with care to determine the appropriateness of the subject number.

The number thus ascertained should be written on the right-hand margin of the paper, near the top, so that it may be seen easily in the

file, thus:



If a person happens to be the subject of the correspondence to be classified and it is made an individual case under a subject heading, the number followed by the surname and full name should be written on the right-hand margin, thus:



Dispatches and outgoing letters will ordinarily bear the file number of the incoming paper on which they are based.

REGISTRATION

Correspondence, incoming and outgoing, is registered in a single

book, of which a specimen page is shown on the overleaf.

In Diplomatic Missions where a comprehensive card index, both of writers and of subjects is maintained, it is not necessary to use the Register of Correspondence. Otherwise the instructions concerning the use to be made of the Register of Correspondence must be fully complied with.

INDEXING

The present book is a general subject index to the files of each office. When, however, the Classification does not afford an adequate index to the correspondence under its appropriate number, card indexes are written. Index cards are necessary for the following:

Names of persons, corporations, societies, etc.

A name index is required, however, only when the person, corporation, or society is the *subject* of the correspondence. In other words, a name card is not made for the *writer* of a letter unless he is at the same time the *subject* of the communication. In Diplomatic Missions where the Register of Correspondence is not used, the writer cards should be made.

Commodities of Commerce, except where the Classification is a sufficient index.

The commodity cards are particularly useful in connection with trade reports. A report on sewing machines would file in 866.12, Foundry and Machine Shop Products, but would be indexed under seving machines.

A subject may be indexed in the Classification to a certain number, as Coal to 863, Mines and Mining, and yet be a matter of correspondence in an entirely different connection, as under 630, Import Tariff. In such a case a card is necessary, as shown in the example on page VII.

Precedent cards will be made for such cases and incidents as will probably be useful for future guidance.

The cards will file under *Precedent*, followed by the file number of the subject matter being precedented according to the Classification of Correspondence.

The practice heretofore prevailing of starting a new index, as well as the copying of the previous index on legal-size sheets for binding with each volume of the year's file, is discontinued. Hereafter the index will be kept in single alphabetical series without reference to

Each index card bears the subject number and the date of the communication originating the correspondence. One card on a given subject referring to a particular number is sufficient for that subject for the calendar year. When in any subsequent year that subject recurs in correspondence, the card will be withdrawn and the date of the communication continuing or reviving the correspondence

will be entered thereon. Only one card will be made for a given subject in any calendar year.

On the register a red-ink check (\checkmark) is made under the names and words on which index cards are written, so that in case of an error the cards may be assembled for correction.

NOTATION OF ACTION


On the face of each incoming paper will be stamped or written the date of its receipt and likewise the date and character of action, as "Acknowledged and to Embassy, June 20, 1923," or "Answered and to Department, July 2, 1923."

ARRANGEMENT OF FILES


Papers are to be kept in manila folders, one such folder for each

particular subject of correspondence.

The folder, which measures approximately 9½ by 15 inches, shows on the exposed margin of the back fold the subject of the contained correspondence and also the number which is assigned by the classification to that subject, thus:



After a folder for general correspondence on a subject, follow in alphabetical order folders for individual cases arising under that subject, as:



In each folder the papers are arranged, whether incoming or outgoing, in the order of their respective dates, save that it is desirable to attach action on a given piece of correspondence to the incoming paper on which it is based without regard to the chronological order. Memoranda and other matters bearing on the subject of the folder should be attached to the correspondence on which they are based. If of a general nature, they should be filed chronologically.

REFERENCE NOTE

A communication having two subjects is classified under the number of the more important one, and an extract or copy of the portion relating to the secondary subject is put in its appropriate dossier. If possible, it is highly desirable, especially in important subjects, to file copies with the secondary subject instead of extracts. For such a reference note the following form should be used:

BINDING

The correspondence is to be bound annually, the papers being arranged first by their file numbers, then by particular cases, then chronologically—each year's volume or volumes containing only correspondence or date in the calendar year.

BINDING OF CIPHER TELEGRAMS

Verbatim texts of code or cipher telegrams received or sent in confidential codes or ciphers must not be bound in the correspondence file. They are registered in the same manner as other correspondence, and paraphrases of them are filed in the appropriate dossiers for future binding; but the original texts of the telegrams will remain in a separate telegram file as provided in circular instruction of June 19, 1908, which file will be bound chronologically as the telegrams accumulate, and the bound volumes kept in the safe or steel cabinet.

DEPARTMENT FILE NUMBERS

For the information of Diplomatic and Consular Offices the following explanation is given of the Department's file numbers and their equivalents in the present book:

The primary divisions, or classes, are the same for both books. Classes 0, 1, and 5 are subdivided in much the same manner. Classes 2 and 4 consist of a single subject each.

In Classes 3, 6, and 7 (as also 2 and 4) in the Department file the two digits on either side of the decimal point (except in 701 to 705) stand for countries, not subjects. In Class 8 the two digits preceding the point represent a country. The country numbers in the following examples are replaced by stars, and the general rule is that by omitting the country numbers and supplying zeros where necessary to make a three-place number, or pointing off three digits before the decimal point, the Department number is converted into the Foreign Service number; thus:

In many instances, however, it has been deemed desirable because of the small volume of correspondence in Diplomatic and Consular Offices on certain subjects, to combine Departmental numbers with other numbers in the present book. For example, routine requests for authentications by the Department of State are classified under 013, while abstract correspondence is classified under 8**.0492. In the Foreign Service Classification, all correspondence concerning authentication of documents is classified under 804.9.
