MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: LLORREGAT-Giner, Antonio

E.O. 13526, section 3.3(b)(1)

- in January 1945 one Antonio LLOBREGAT, a Spaniard, was reportedly an employee of a German firm which held a concession from the Spanish police for the radio location of clandestine radio transmitters. LLOBREGAT's position served as a cover for the operation from his flat of a German Intelligence Service clandestine radio transmitter. In January 1945 LLOBREGAT's address was Ronda de la Universidad 6, first floor, Barcelona.
- 2. The above information was furnished to the Immigration and Naturalization Service in CSCI-3751494, dated 11 September 1958, Subject: LLOBREGAT-Giner, Antonio. An investigation conducted by the Immigration and Naturalization Service did not establish that Antonio LLOBREGAT was identical with Antonio LLOBREGAT-Giner, subject of private bill S 4190.
