RM Self-Assessments

- ▣ Quick look back
 - Released Sept 28, 2009
 - Results captured during FY 10, Qtr 1
 - 34 questions on basics of RM programs with special section on E-mail management
- ▣ Current status
 - Received 226 out of 253 recipients, 90 percent
 - Analysis ongoing, refining approach to scoring, which will be based on perceived risk
 - Report due in March 2010

RM Self-Assessments

- ▣ Preliminary conclusions
 - E-mail and e-records management continue to present challenges for agencies regardless of agency size
 - Cabinet-level agencies with multiple components frequently had contradictory responses
 - Scores will be reported for components as well as Departments as whole
- ▣ Next Steps
 - FY 10 self-assessment will be released in June with more time to respond

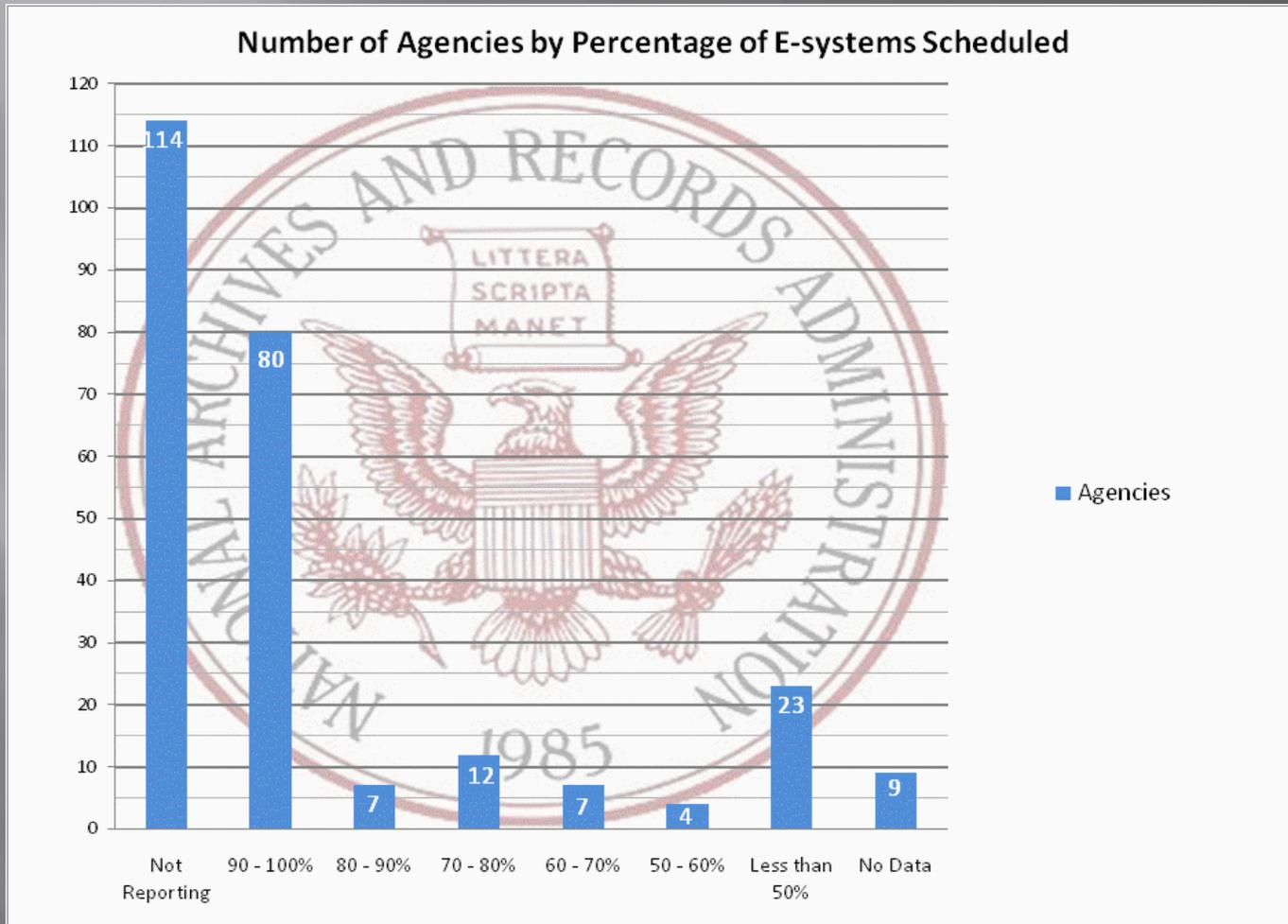

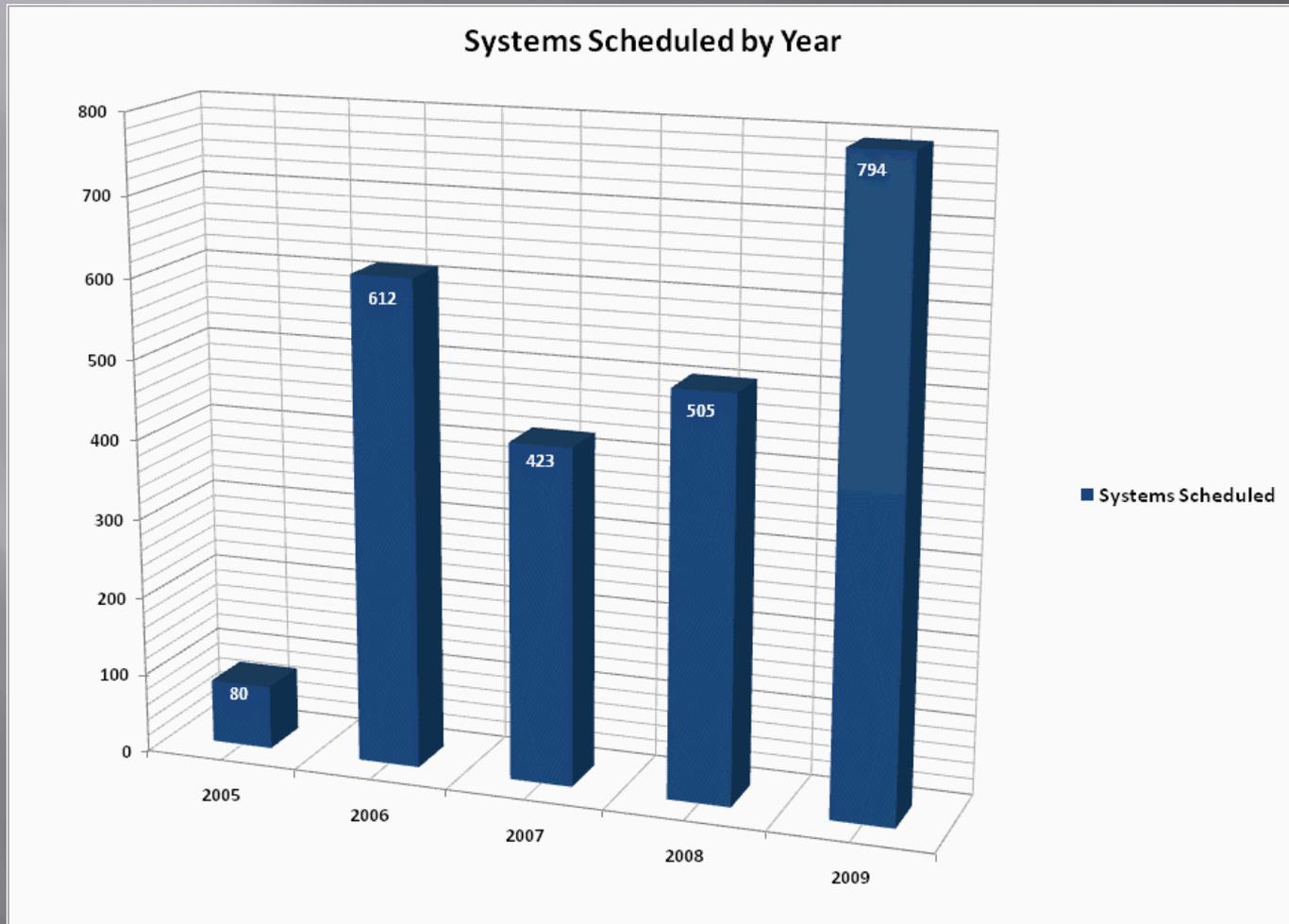
FY 2009 E-Records Reporting

- ▣ Currently working on summary report of E-records scheduling and transfer activities from FY 2005 – FY 2010
- ▣ Response was fair, peaking in September; still much to do
 - ▣ Reports received from 142 of 256 agencies >>> 55 percent
 - ▣ As of October 1, 2009, only 34% of all agencies are at 80% compliance level
- ▣ Preliminary data
 - Agency responses according to percentage completion
 - Number of electronic records and systems scheduled by year

FY 2009 E-Records Reporting

- ▣ NARA Bulletin 2010-02 (Feb 25, 2010) supersedes previous E-Records Bulletins 2006-02 and 2008-03
- ▣ Newest requirement will be regular semi-annual reporting one-records scheduling status
 - March 31
 - September 30
- ▣ Attachment with guidance and tips to assist agencies in scheduling their e-records and systems
