	<u>Army Nuclear Test Personnel Review (ANTPR), 1978-1987</u>  From 1978 to 1987 the U.S. Army was involved in a research program to identify and assign radiation exposure doses to approximately 50,000 people who participated in the Nuclear Test Program conducted between 1945 and 1962. The study encompassed the entire dose reconstruction effort and indicated the methodology and processes used in dose reconstructions had sound scientific merit. JAYCOR completed its contractual work on September 23, 1987. ANTPR responsibilities were then assumed by the Defense Nuclear Agency.  Disposition: Permanent; transfer data files, documentation, and copy of final report to National Archives.
