Background: On 13 Jun 94, the Acting Archivist of the United States (N1-AU-90-23) approved a change to the disposition of DOD Wage Setting records. This change approved a permanent disposition for records converted to electronic format, with disposal of the supporting hardcopy records set at 10 years. This authority superseded NC1-AU-78-51, 20 Apr 78, recognizing the value of these hardcopy records as permanent. Wage setting authority has since split, with appropriated fund authority going to DLA and nonappropriated fund authority going to DLA and nonappropriated fund (CPMS-AWN), whose records are administered by the Army. CPMS-AWN has requested we reinstate the permanent disposition for hardcopy records that were not converted to electronic form since the data contained in them would be considered permanent if they were converted.
