	<p>(A note to the appraiser. Components of the Casualty Program are Southeast Asia Casualty Data Base (SEACAS), Korean Conflict Casualty File-II (KCCF-II), (both of these were submitted on a separate SF-115), and Worldwide Military Service Casualty Program (WWMSC) (submitted here.) All casualties in the SEACAS and KCCF-II have been declared dead; therefore, the Privacy Act of 1974 does not apply to records of these systems. However, not all casualties in the WWMSC have been declared dead. The same cautions that must be exercised in handling material subject to the Privacy Act must be used in handling WWMSC records. There is no requirement to publish a system notice for WWMSC although it is a consolidation of the Services casualty systems, which are published Privacy Systems. All transfers of electronic files shall be made in accordance with the standards set forth in 36 CFR 1228.</p> <p>2b. Korean Conflict Casualty File-II Technical Documentation, to facilitate NARA machine use of KCCF-II. Documentation submitted must include the same information requested on NA Form 14097 or an actual, completed NA Form 14097.</p> <p><u>Disposition:</u> Permanent. Technical documentation is to be submitted at the same time the KCCF-II file is transferred to the National Archives.</p>
