1. The Office of the Secretary of Defense's Radiation Experiments Command Center (RECC) Information System.

The RECC Information System consists of four automated databases: 1) The Library Database; 2) The Event File; 3) The Case/Subjects Database; and 4) The Nasal Pharyngeal Radium Irradiation (NRI) Database.

1.1 The Library Database, 1906 - current.

The Library Database consists of records about books, publications, and other documents related to human radiation experiments and the United States Department of Defense as collected by the RECC. Records are in a bibliographical format and include: The name of a corporate or individual author, and the title of a document, report, or other textual material. The database records are accessed by an accession number. The database is used primarily as an index to the RECC's textual collections.

DISPOSITION: <u>Permanent</u>. At the end of the RECC program, transfer the database to the United States National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). Transfer should be according to 36 CFR 1228.188.

1.2 The Event File, 1942 - 1996.

The Event File consists of records related to human radiation experiments (HRE) referred to as events and the United States Department of Defense as collected by the RECC. The database records are accessed by an accession number known as the event number. The database is used primarily as an index to the RECC's textual HRE Project List.

DISPOSITION: <u>Permanent</u>. At the end of the RECC program, transfer the database to the United States National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). Transfer should be according to 36 CFR 1228.188.
