1. CENTRAL FOREIGN POLICY FILE.

The official centralized file of the Department of State which incorporates records and documents of a substantive nature that establish, discuss, or define foreign policy and its development and implementation. Included are telegrams, written documents such as general correspondence, inter-agency correspondence, congressional correspondence, reports, memorandums, diplomatic notes, email messages, and other communications and documentation. Also included is metadata relating to all the documentation.

- a. **Written Correspondence System.** Text and citations to records in the Written Correspondence system or successor. Records may be on film, image, or other format.

PERMANENT. Transfer to the National Archives on an annual basis when no more than 25 years old after declassification review.

- b. **Telegrams.** Texts and header information of electronically transmitted communications.

1. Records that are Subject TAGSed with only one or more of the Subject TAGS designated as "Temporary" on the attached schedule.

Temporary. Destroy upon expiration of the longest retention period assigned to the Subject TAGS associated with a given record.

2. All other records, including all messages and citations with one or more of the Subject TAGS designated as permanent on the attached schedule.

PERMANENT. Transfer to the National Archives on an annual basis when no more than 25 years old after declassification review. NOTE: Microfilm of telegrams shall be transferred to the National Archives to serve as a backup and to fill gaps in the electronic files.
