


1. Commercial Vehicle Information Systems and Networks (CVISN) Web Site (New Item)

The Commercial Vehicle Information Systems and Networks (CVISN) Web Site is an informational web site that contains descriptive CVISN programmatic and reference documents, overall system architecture documents, and CVISN training materials. The CVISN program provides a programmatic and system architecture that organizes and funds the deployment of a collection of information systems and communications networks that support commercial vehicle operators to include information systems owned and operated by governments, motor carriers, and other stakeholders.

1. Data Quality Tracking System (DataQs) and Website (New Item)

The FMCSA Data Quality Tracking System and Website (DataQs) is an electronic means for filing and tracking the resolutions of concerns about allegedly inaccurate Federal and State data released to the public by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA). Through this system, data concerns, or "Requests for Data Reviews" (RDRs) are automatically forwarded to the appropriate office for resolution. The system also allows filers to monitor the status of each filing.

Specifically, DataQs provides an Internet website to accept RDRs and supporting documentation (fax and/or file upload capability), acknowledges receipt of RDRs, notifies FMCSA and/or State personnel when RDRs are received, accepts FMCSA and/or State postings and responses related to RDRs, provides automated notification capability including receipt of input and status changes, provides reporting capability based on pre-set parameters, and tracks RDRs from submission through resolution.

Disposition Cut off at the end of the year. Transfer resolved RDR's to archival system after 3 years.

Disposition Temporary. Delete 2 years after transfer to archival data file, or when no longer needed for business, legal, reference or administrative operations.
