Records filed with the Surface Transportation Board under new 49 U.S. C. 10706, Rate Agreements: exemption from antitrust laws and 49 U.S.C. 13703, Certain collective activities; exemption from antitrust laws, include railroad and motor carrier rate bureau agreements and amendments submitted for Board approval, confidential transcripts or sound recordings of rate bureau meetings and voting records, and shipper agreements with regard to compensation for the use by rail carriers of shipper-owned or leased rolling stock.  Records were formerly filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission under 49 U.S.C. 10706(a) and (b). Section 10706(a) pertained to railroads and section 10706(b) pertained to motor carriers.
