Description:

The Thomas Jefferson Commemoration Commission was established by Public Law 102-343 (106 Stat. 915) on August 17, 1992, to commemorate the 250th anniversary of the birth of Thomas Jefferson, April 13, 1743. However, due to the presidential transition, the Commission did not start until July 1993, three months after the anniversary they were set up to commemorate. It lost half of its funding for 1993 and had to seek funding from outside foundations and sources. In spite of the late beginning of the Commission and its lack of funding, the Commission was able to fulfill many of its goals. While Congress passed legislation (107 Stat. 2291; Public Law 103-191) to extend the Commission's authorization into 1994, the legislation did not authorize the expenditure of additional funds. On March 15, 1994, the Commission submitted an interim report to the President. The Commission terminated in November 1994.
