We, the undersigned, having executed the *State of Oklahoma Presidential Elector Oath or Affirmation* have sworn to uphold our statutory duty as outlined in Section 10-102 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

Hereby Certify, a vote by two distinct ballots was held; first, for President of the United States, and then, for Vice President of the United States; and
