General Notes: There is a large amount of duplicated material, including reference prints, reproduced negatives and secondary material that had been collected. Wellcome had his own filing system; original order has been maintained as much as possible. "Ribbon copy" refers to original type-written documents, as opposed to carbon copies. There are indexes to both the originals of the A – L files and the copies. The folder list has been typed according to the folder title, which accounts for labeling differences, and abbreviations. There is a key to the system breakdown in the Penfield series

Administrative History:

There are eighteen separate series to the Wellcome Collection. Transferred in 1961 to the National Archives, the records were originally accessioned under Record Group (RG) 200. In 1996, RG200 was eliminated and re-designated as the Donated Materials Record Group. The collection originated out of Wellcome's office in Washington, D.C., operating under the occupation of the Metlakahtla case.

Wellcome was an avid supporter of Father William Duncan in his fight to retain control over the mission settlement on Annette Island, going so far as to establish an office in Washington, DC, to enable political and social support. Wellcome continued the political activism even after Duncan's death. The bulk of this collection and the operation of that office surround the pursuant action of those claims.

The records were transferred from the Seattle branch to the Anchorage branch in 1991 and a detailed folder list was created at that time. More than 900 pictures have been scanned and uploaded to ARC, but there is no other online content available. Because the collection has been in NARA's possession for more than fifty years, there are finding materials that are referenced under old Record Group numbers, and older box locations may not be correct.

The Wellcome Collection comprises 298 boxes, rolled maps and photo albums that have been divided into eighteen series. Wellcome, as a man, was interested in medicine, pharmacology, chemistry, archaeology, nautical sciences, and anthropology, among other fields. His goal was to create a "Museum of Man", and at the time of his death, his collection exceeded that of the Louvre. His frequent travels combined with his interest in the Duncan case led to journeys to Alaska, producing a cultural documentation of early 20th-century Alaska. Through this travel, and because of his association with Duncan, Wellcome produced a book, "The Story of Metlakahtla". Additionally, there are both originals and copies of correspondence, documents, and personal papers, records of the Metlakahtla case,

photos, glass-plate negatives, photo albums, governmental correspondence, and manuscript material. There are over 2000 photographs of Native Americans, towns and villages throughout Southeastern Alaska, the Klondike and Alaskan gold rush. There are another 1500 photographs of Metlakahtla, British Columbia that show the settlement, residents and buildings. There are also galley sheets for a report by Mark Matthews, and material pertaining to the Hunter Report, done by Donald V. Hunter, reporting to the Secretary of the Interior by Committee on Matters Pertaining to Annette Island Reserve, Alaska, dated May 3, 1927.

Wellcome created his own filing system, with an elaborate index to understanding the location of material. For example, the "A" files are "Governmental Document" and pertain to education in Alaska. "G" files are newspaper and periodicals which may or may not relate to the Metlakahtla case. Copies are marked with its alphabetical designation, folder number, and number within the folder. Series are arranged by first letter designation of the filing scheme, then folder number followed by chronological designation. There are a good many duplications within the files that attribute to the collection size.

This series is comprised of approximately 30 cubic feet of 3x5 cards. The subject titles represent names, places and topic. Each card identifies the subject matter of a document, gives its location within the A - L file and a brief description. They are arranged alphabetically by subject. Because Wellcome created his own filing system, the office manager created this index in an effort to properly file and account for material. There is no original documentation in this series; it was merely a tool to facilitate finding information when the collection was active. There is a 242 page alphabetical spreadsheet that has been created, allowing researchers to search by card subject title and see the beginning and ending dates. The index does not give specifically what materials are contained; only that the topic exists within the collection, and the location within Wellcome's A - L classification, not its current box location. This spreadsheet is Appendix A.

This file (ca. 1864 – 1930) contains compiled original documents, Photostats, and printed matter from which material has been reproduced. There is a lot of duplication and many of the copies are attached to source documents, however it represents the whole file on a topic, as worked, thought or understood by Wellcome. Series contains correspondence, including but not limited to Father William Duncan, Sheldon Jackson, and Sir Henry Wellcome as well Metlakahtla Council correspondence, material from A. J. Strong, and Dr. and Mrs. Matilda Minthorn. (Mr. and Mrs. Minthorn were missionaries in Alaska. They were also President Herbert Hoover's aunt and uncle, who finished raising him.) Topics include, but are not limited to: native statements during the Metlakahtla Case, the totem pole issue of 1899, building of "the case" as referred to by Wellcome, issues with the Salvation Army, education in Metlakahtla, materials related to the 60th anniversary celebration for Father Duncan, difficulties with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Bureau of the Interior, and Father Duncan's visits to Washington, DC. Arranged by letter designation of the A – L files, then chronologically.
