Series Description: This series contains the daily log sheets (1902-1941). They detail the activities of the station, patrols, and weather. The daily log sheets also take note of the ships' movements, U.S. mail, transport of U.S. Marshals' prisoners, insane people and other wards of the government, contacts with the Bering Sea Patrol, rescues, activities of aircraft and personnel matter of the station. In the influenza epidemic of 1918-1919, the station dispatched teams by dog sled to transport medicine and provide care for native villages in the area.
