Series Title: Alaska Federal Food Administrator 1917 - 1919

General Notes: There is a scattered set of some of the promotional material in the Alaska Railroad material.

Administrative history: Established as an independent agency by EO 2679-A, August 10, 1917, under authority of the Food and Fuel Control Act (40 Stat. 276), August 10, 1917, replacing a volunteer organization established May 4, 1917. Alaska was divided into 4 regions that corresponded to the judicial districts. The office was created November, 1917 and closed 15 February, 1919.

Series Description: This series consists of general correspondence relating to administrative concerns, conservation and consumption of food, food supplies, public education, wholesale and retail food costs, and the users of commercial quantities of rationed commodities. In addition, there is extensive documentation relating to the fishing industry, the annual salmon pack and related issues. Also included are copies of the Official Food News Bulletins for August - November 1918, card lists of various licenses and sugar ration cards for Treadwell, Alaska.
