**Series Description:** This series consists of correspondence, reports, and memorandums. The records document the work of the National Recovery Administration for Alaska's businesses and industries. The records were last maintained by staff of the Territorial office. The main industries documented are mining, logging, and fishing. Almost all other business enterprises also came under code regulations including boat building and repair; commercial aviation; construction; hotels; public utilities; restaurants; radio and movie broadcasting; retail stores such as drug, grocery, and jewelry stores and newspaper publishing. Subjects covered include trade associations; wage and hour regulations; labor unions; trade practices; and marketing policies. Also included are documents detailing complaints relating to child labor, alien employment, and unfair competition. There are some petitions for exemption from code regulations.
