Docket Books: This series consists mainly of over-size ledger books of jail registers, and docket books. They are mainly from Anchorage, but Cordova, Chitina, Dillingham, Knik, Kodiak, Katalla, Naknek, McCarthy, Copper Center, Valdez, Matanuska and other towns are represented. Dates range from the early 1900s through the late 1960s with the majority of the material ranging from approximately 1915 through the 1950s.

Historical Files: This series consists of records created during the day-to-day execution of Marshals operations in territorial Alaska. These materials include court proceedings, documents pertaining to estate and guardianship matters, recordations of contracts, docket books and some effects of deceased persons, held in trust.
