

3. SOON AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE HAIDAR WAS RETURNED TO ARGENTINA WHERE HE LED [REDACTED] TO 17 MILLION DOLLARS HIDDEN IN A SAFESITE IN CORDOBA AND TO FOUR MILLION DOLLARS HIDDEN IN MENDOZA. AS A RESULT OF ALL OF THESE OPERATIONS INVOLVING HAIDAR, THE FINANCIAL RESERVES OF THE MONTONEROS HAVE BEEN VIRTUALLY ELIMINATED.

4. AS OF LATE MARCH 1977, ONE TO TWO MILLION DOLLARS OF THE MONEY OBTAINED FROM THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY HAIDAR IS MISSING [REDACTED]

no indication on either section of the letter as to its date, originator, or recipient. The sections are marked "1" and "4", and read as follows, respectively.

A. "1. I am sorry about the delay over the names and addresses which I promised for you so long ago. I wanted to have them checked by (words cut out) and by the Center for National Security Studies (CNSS) in Washington. The Center is a group of people, many of whom like [redacted] have left the various U.S. organizations, and who are working for reform - some of them are not exactly revolutionary but they have files and material on U.S. espionage and related topics.

"I have had the names we found checked by (word cut out) but not yet by the CNSS. They seem to be on holiday. But I spoke on the phone to them before I left (word or words cut out) and they promised that they would try to work on them this week for me. So I may be able to confirm more when I get back to the office next week."

[redacted] Comment: The CNSS describes itself as an organization working to curtail the present Executive Branch secrecy system and drastically reduce the secrecy which presently veils national security policies.)

B. "4. P.S.: ^{ARG. 45} There may be a number of further names. But one thing could be useful. A secretary in the embassy, [redacted] has a husband named [redacted]. He is not embassy personnel, but we have
