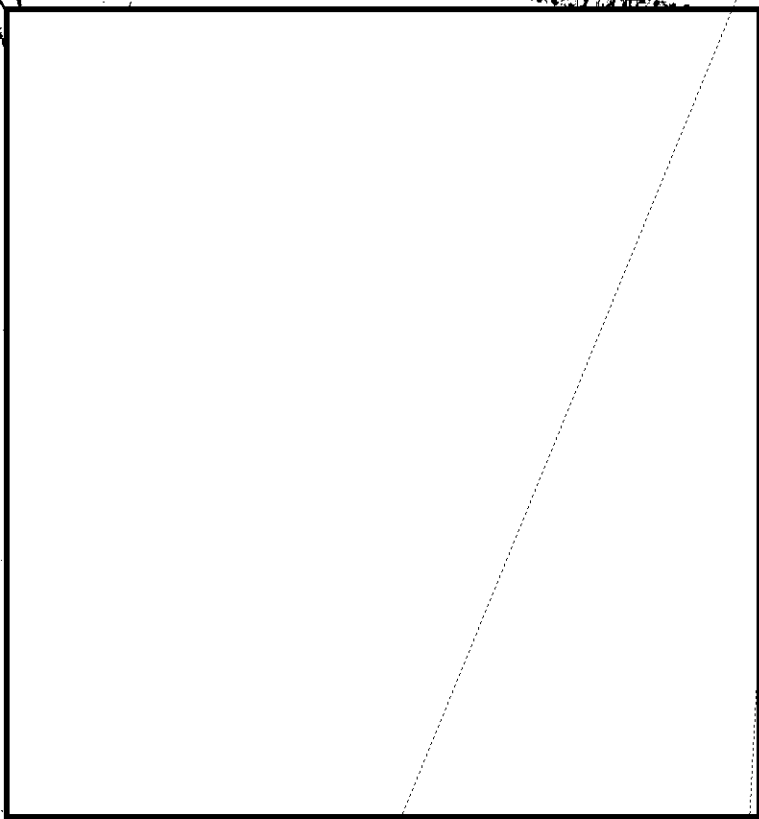

PERONIST MOVEMENT, AN ARGENTINE SUBVERSIVE MOVEMENT, THAT THE
MONTONEROS PLAN TO INCREASE THEIR ACTIVITIES BOTH INSIDE
ARGENTINA AND ABROAD. ACCORDING TO THE INFORMATION, MARIO
F I R M E N I C H, SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE MONTONEROS, ISSUED
INSTRUCTIONS IN MARCH THAT MONTONEROS IN EUROPE SHOULD TRAVEL TO
CUBA, MEXICO, AND NICARAGUA IN ORDER TO "CONTRIBUTE TO REVOLUTIONARY
ACTIVITIES" IN CENTRAL AMERICA. FIRMENICH EMPHASIZED THAT THOSE
MONTONEROS WHO WENT TO CUBA WOULD ONLY REMAIN THERE A SHORT TIME
BEFORE MOVING ON TO OTHER AREAS; HE ALSO ASSURED THOSE MONTONEROS
ALREADY ASSIGNED TO CUBA THAT THEY WOULD NOT BE "OUT OF ACTION"
FOR LONG PERIODS OF ISOLATION IN CUBA.

3. ON 5 APRIL, RADIO MONITORS [REDACTED] INTERCEPTED A MONTONEPO BROADCAST FROM A PIRATE TRANSMITTER THAT CALLED ITSELF "RADIO LIBERATION". THE TRANSMISSION LASTED SIX TO EIGHT MINUTES AND WAS MOST CLEARLY HEARD ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF BUENOS AIRES IN THE AREAS OF QUILMES, LA PLATA, AND BERAZATEGUI, WHICH ARE HEAVILY POPULATED BY WORKING CLASS FAMILIES. THE BROADCAST OPENED AND CLOSED WITH THE PERONIST MARCH, AND IT INCLUDED SEVERE CRITICISM OF THE ARGENTINE MILITARY GOVERNMENT AND ITS ECONOMIC POLICIES. THE BROADCAST WAS CLEARLY HEARD IN AN AREA WITH A RADIUS OF FIVE TO NINE KILOMETERS. [REDACTED]

4. [REDACTED] COMMENT: INACTIVE MONTONEROS HAVE OFTEN BECOME DISAFFECTED OR DRIFTED AWAY FROM THE MOVEMENT WHILE IN EXILE. THE PARTICIPATION OF MONTONERO MEMBERS IN REVOLUTIONARY ACTIVITIES IN CENTRAL AMERICA SHOULD HEIGHTEN THEIR STATE OF READINESS AND COMMITMENT TO THE MOVEMENT. IN ADDITION, MONTONERO PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES IN CENTRAL AMERICA WOULD GIVE THE MONTONEROS A CLAIM ON FOREIGN COOPERATION FOR A CAMPAIGN IN ARGENTINA FOLLOWING A REVOLUTIONARY VICTORY IN CENTRAL AMERICA.)

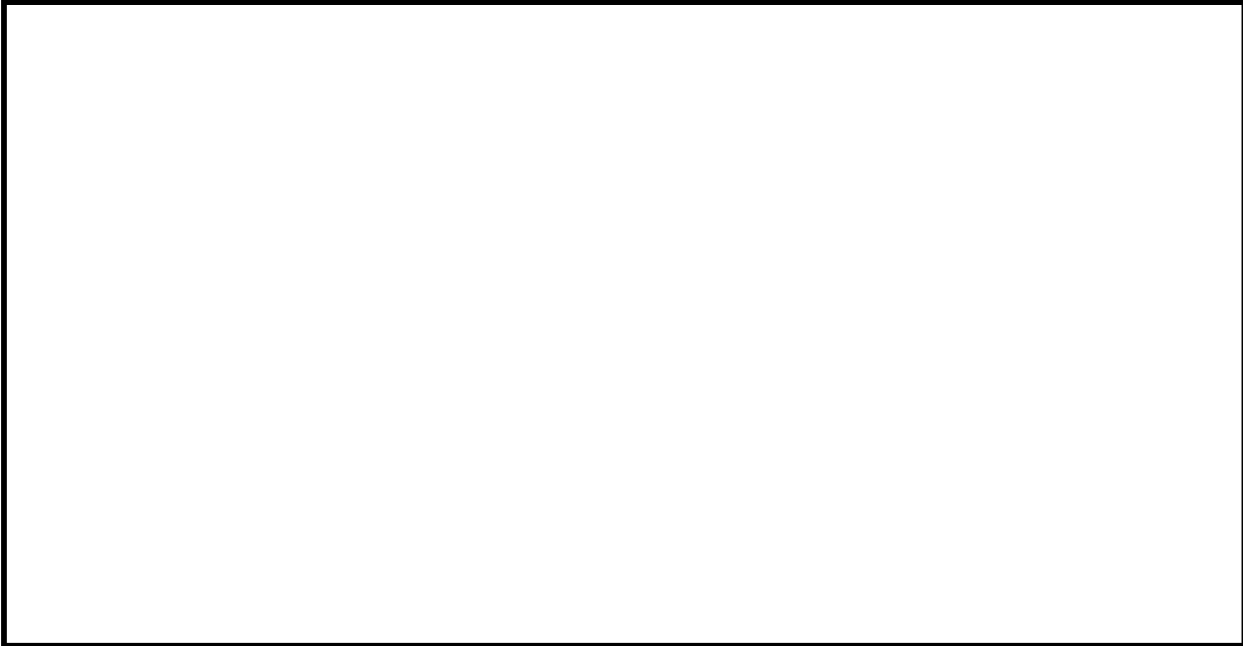

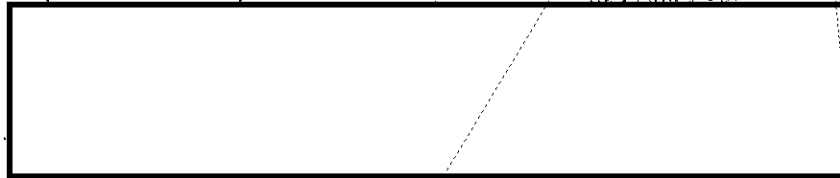

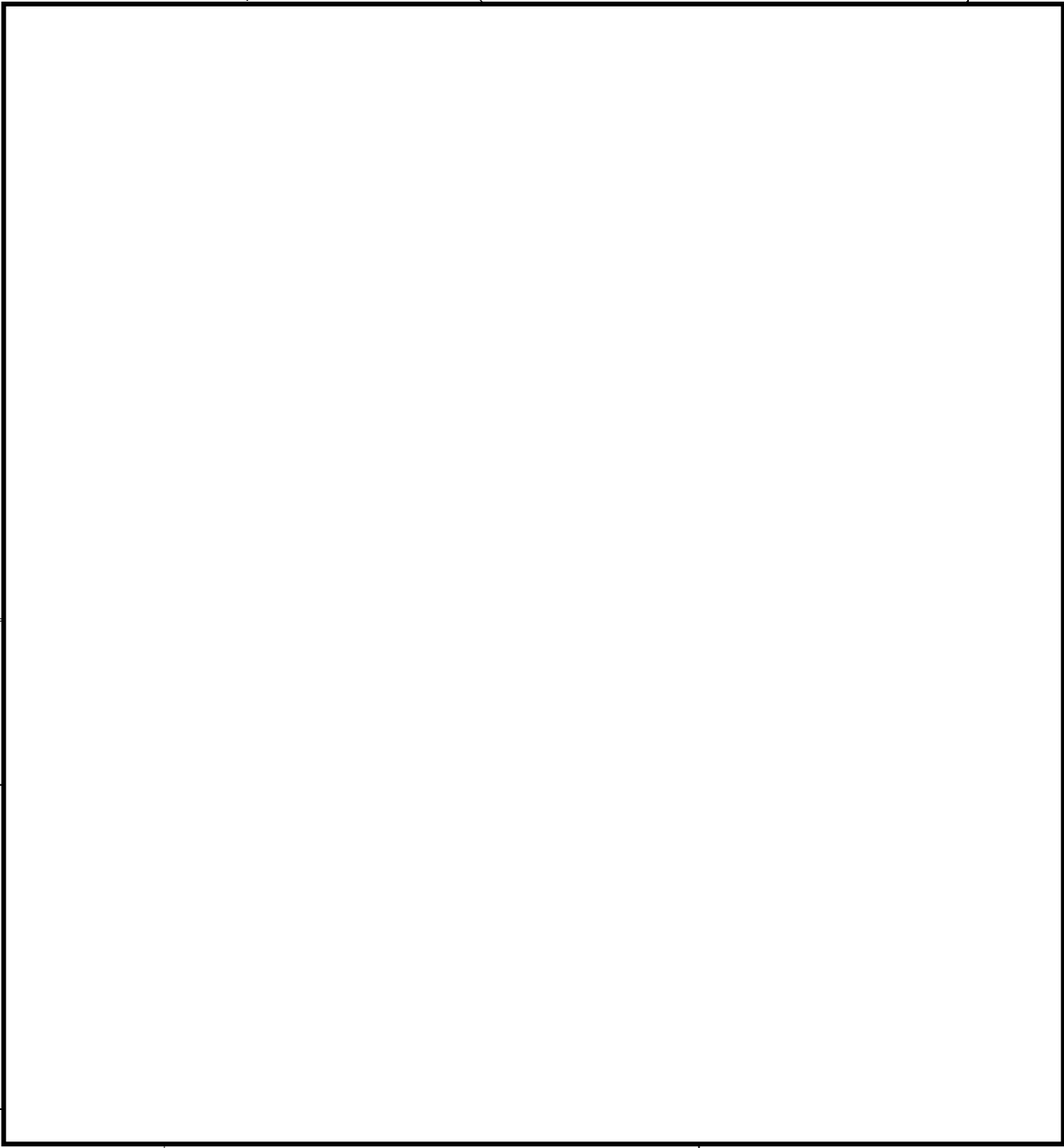
