WHILE SOURCE IDENTIFIES CANO AS FORMER LEADER OF THE MONTONEROS, DIA IDENTIFIES FIREMINICH AS PRINCIPAL MONTONERO LEADER SINCE 1970. HE IS COMMANDER IN CHIEF OF THE MONTONERO ARMY AND SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE PARTY AND OF THE MOVEMENT.
