This letter is in reference to my previous communication concerning your Freedom of Information-Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request.

An exceedingly heavy volume of FOIPA requests has been received these past few months. Additionally, court deadlines involving certain historical cases of considerable scope have been imposed upon the FBI. Despite successive expansions of our staff responsible for FOIPA matters, substantial delays in processing requests continue.

The FBI has 4,233 FOIPA requests on hand. Processing has begun, and is in various stages of completion on 1,110 of those cases. It will not be possible for the FBI to meet all workday deadlines previously made. In an effort to deal fairly with any request requiring the retrieval, processing and duplication of documents, each request is being handled in chronological order based on the date of receipt. Please be assured that your request is being handled as equitably as possible and that all documents which can be released will be made available at the earliest possible date.

To expedite release of any documents which may pertain to you, please submit your notarized signature. This procedure is designed to insure that information concerning an individual is released only to that person.

Your patience and cooperation will be appreciated.

The Intelligence Division has reviewed the attached excised documents concerning the requestor, Rev. John P. Egan, and sufficient deletions have been made with the exception of serial 100-465863-1. Page 5, paragraph 3, pertains to information furnished by NK 3284-S who furnished information until June, 1972, and identity was not disclosed. It is noted that the information pertains to an autobiographical diary type theme that requestor distributes to his friends; however, it is not known the amount of distribution and this release could possibly identify source. This also applies to page 6, paragraph 4, page 7 and page 8, paragraphs 1, 2, and 3.

Information concerning the requestor which appears on the following serials in the paragraphs listed are not classifiable. Therefore, the classification of the document will not be dealt with at this time.

The main file concerning the requestor (100-465863) has been reviewed for classification. 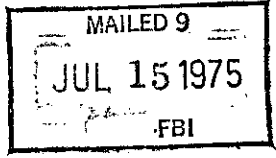
