The information furnished herewith concerns an individual or organization believed to be covered by the agreement between the FBI and Secret Service concerning protective responsibilities, and to fall within the category or categories checked.

- 1. Threats or actions against persons protected by Secret Service.
- 2. Attempts or threats to redress grievances.
- 3. Threatening or abusive statement about U. S. or foreign official.
- 4. Participation in civil disturbances, anti-U. S. demonstrations or hostile incidents against foreign diplomatic establishments.
- 5. Illegal bombing, bomb-making or other terrorist activity.
- 6. Defector from U. S. or indicates desire to defect.
- 7. Potentially dangerous because of background, emotional instability or activity in groups engaged in activities inimical to U. S.

Information obtained confidentially. It is noted that informant will not testify under any circumstances and that his reliability has been untested at this time.

Informant advised that an individual (FNU) Aldunate is an unknown member of the Leftist Terrorist Group known as the Montoneros which operates largely in Argentina. Informant stated that Aldunate is employed at the United Nations and works for the South American Human Rights Movement which has an office located within the United Nations Towers, New York City, New York, directly opposite the United Nations Building.

Informant advised that this office is managed by an unknown female plus five other unknown males, three of these males are full time members of the Montoneros Terrorist Group. Informant stated that the Montoneros are known to kidnap and ransom wealthy United States business executives abroad and might contemplate the same idea in the New York City area.

Informant stated that he heard Aldunate had a father who was a former politician in Uruguay whose name was Ferrira Aldunate. Informant further advised that Aldunate has visited President Carter on at least two occasions in relation to the Human Rights Program. Aldunate has also been frequently seen in the presence of several United States Senators in the Washington, D.C. area.

Informant further advised that this individual, ALDUNATE, is presently employed at the United Nations and works for the South American Human Rights Movement located in the United Nations Office Towers, NYC, NY. Information stated that this office is managed by an unknown female plus five other unknown males.

Three of these males are full-time agents for the Montoneros leftist terrorists group.

Source stated that the Montoneros terrorist group has kidnapped wealthy United States businessmen abroad and might try something in the New York City area. Source further advised that ALDUNATE's father was a former politician in Uruguay and believed his name to be FERRIRA ALDUNATE. Source stated that to his knowledge ALDUNATE has visited President CARTER on at least two occasions in relation to the Human Rights program in South America and has been seen on several occasions in the presence of prominent United States Senators. Source advised that ALDUNATE has a free reign in the United States to make contact under the disguise of working for the South American Human Rights Movement and uses the telephones for contacts without worry of traces since he is in the United Nations Office Tower.
