OUR REPRESENTATIVE IN BUENOS AIRES REPORTED THAT ON MAY 13, 1975, IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT ARGENTINE ARMY COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF LIEUTENANT GENERAL LEANDRO ENRIQUE ANAYA HAD RESIGNED HIS POSITION FROM THE ARGENTINE ARMY. [ON MAY 13, 1975, A ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~ SOURCE, WHO HAS FURNISHED RELIABLE INFORMATION IN THE PAST AND WHO IS A PROMINENT OFFICIAL OF THE ARGENTINE ARMY INTELLIGENCE SERVICE, ADVISED THAT GENERAL ANAYA'S RESIGNATION HAD BEEN REQUESTED BY THE ARGENTINE MINISTER OF DEFENSE DURING THE EVENING OF MAY 12, 1975, AND THAT ANAYA HAD IMMEDIATELY COMPLIED WITH THE MINISTER'S REQUEST. THE SOURCE ADVISED THAT ANAYA'S RESIGNATION WAS IN NO WAY CONNECTED WITH ANY POSSIBLE ARMY COUP AGAINST THE CONSTITUTIONAL ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT.]
