INFORMATIVE NOTE

Date 12/18/75

Attached from Legat, Buenos Aires, advises Argentine Air Force (AAA) officers closed down the Buenos Aires Metropolitan Airport on the morning of December 18, 1975. AAA middle grade officers were reported in rebellion and to have placed the AAA commander-in-chief under house arrest. There are two versions regarding the purpose of the rebellion. One is that the junior officers have initiated a coup d'etat and will be joined by the Argentine Army and Navy in order to overthrow the incumbent Peronist government. The second version, considered more plausible, is that AAA junior officers are extremely displeased over what they consider political maneuvering in the recently published AAA promotion and reassignment schedule. The AAA commander-in-chief has consistently removed AAA officers believed challenging his position. As of 12:30 p.m., 12/18/75, Buenos Aires time, a closed meeting of Argentine Navy Admirals was being held, purpose not known.

The above information was furnished by the U. S. Embassy, Buenos Aires to State Department, Washington, D.C., by flash telegram. Embassy personnel are taking security precautions.

 FOREIGN POLITICAL MATTERS-ARGENTINA; IS-ARGENTINA.

DURING THE MORNING OF DECEMBER 18, 1975, THE ARGENTINE AIR FORCE CLOSED JORGE NEWBERRY DOWNTOWN METROPOLITAN AIRPORT IN BUENOS AIRES FOR UNEXPLAINED REASONS. SUBSEQUENTLY IT WAS REVEALED THAT JUNIOR MIDDLE GRADE OFFICERS OF THE ARGENTINE AIR FORCE WERE IN REBELLION AND HAD PLACED THE AIR FORCE COMMANDER IN CHIEF UNDER HOUSE ARREST. THERE ARE TWO CONFLICTING VERSIONS REGARDING THE PURPOSE OF THE AIR FORCE REVOLT. ONE IS THAT THE AIR FORCE JUNIOR OFFICERS HAVE INITIATED THE BEGINNING OF A COUP D'ETAT AND WILL BE JOINED BY THE ARGENTINE NAVY AND ARMY IN ORDER TO OVERTHROW THE INCUMBENT PERONIST GOVERNMENT. THE SECOND VERSION AND PROBABLY THE MOST PLAUSIBLE IS THAT JUNIOR AIR FORCE OFFICERS WERE EXTREMELY DISPLEASED OVER WHAT THEY CONSIDERED TO BE POLITICAL MANEUVERING IN THE RECENTLY PUBLISHED AIR FORCE PROMOTION AND REASSIGNMENT SCHEDULE. IT IS NOTED THAT THE AIR FORCE COMANDER IN CHIEF HAS CONSISTENTLY REMOVED FROM CENTER STATE ANY OFFICER

FOREGOING HAS BEEN PROVIDED BY THE BUENOS AIRES EMBASSY TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT IN WASHINGTON, D.C. BY FLASH TELEGRAM. IT IS PROVIDED ONLY FOR THE INFORMATION OF THE BUREAU. I AM CLOSELY FOLLOWING THIS MATTER AND WILL KEEP THE BUREAU CURRENTLY ADVISED.

OFFICE PERSONNEL ARE TAKING APPROPRIATE SECURITY PRECAUTIONS.
