ON MARCH 18, 1976, A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE ABROAD WHO IS A RANKING OFFICIAL OF THE ARGENTINE ARMY INTELLIGENCE SERVICE (AAIS) PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

INFORMATION RECEIVED BY THE AAIS FROM THE HIGHEST LEVELS OF THE ARGENTINE ARMY INDICATE THAT THE ARGENTINE MILITARY WILL STAGE A COUP D'ETAT AGAINST THE INCUMBENT PERONIST GOVERNMENT ON SATURDAY, MARCH 20, 1976 OR POSSIBLY SUNDAY, MARCH 21, 1976

ACCORDING TO A RECENT REPORT PASSED FROM THE ARGENTINE ARMY HIGH COMMAND, TEN COUNTRIES HAVE ALREADY INFORMALLY ADVISED ARGENTINE MILITARY ATTACHES IN THOSE COUNTRIES THAT IMMEDIATE RECOGNITION WOULD BE PROVIDED TO AN ARGENTINE MILITARY GOVERNMENT.

THE FUTURE ARGENTINE MILITARY INCUMBENTS OF ALL IMPORTANT POSITIONS IN THE GOVERNMENT HAVE ALREADY BEEN DECIDED. FOR EXAMPLE, GENERAL DALLA TEA OF THE ARGENTINE ARMY HIGH COMMAND IS SLATED TO BECOME THE SECRETARY TO THE ARGENTINE PRESIDENCY.

THE AAIS HAS BEEN RECEIVING DISTURBING REPORTS THAT JUNIOR MILITARY OFFICERS INTEND TO TAKE MATTERS INTO THEIR OWN HANDS PRIOR TO THE COUP D'ETAT WITH SPECIFIC TARGETING AGAINST LABOR UNION LEADERS WHOM THEY CONSIDER TO BE LEFTISTS OR ESPECIALLY CORRUPT. THE AAIS IS CLOSELY FOLLOWING THIS MATTER IN AN EFFORT TO TAKE PREVENTIVE ACTION AGAINST THESE YOUNGER OFFICERS.
