- 1. THE ARGENTINE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES (PRAT GUY) WAS CALLED IN BY THE DEPUTY SECRETARY ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 12 TO DISCUSS THE HUMAN RIGHTS SITUATION IN ARGENTINA AND ITS IMPLICATIONS FOR US-ARGENTINE RELATIONS.
- 2.
