Argentine Politicians' Request for Appointment

ISSUE FOR DECISION

Whether to meet with five exiled Argentine former politicians who are seeking an appointment with you.

ESSENTIAL FACTORS

The Council on Hemispheric Affairs has written to you requesting an appointment at a time to be agreed upon for five exiled former Argentine politicians. five -- Esteban Righi, a Minister of Interior under Campora, Santiago Diaz Ortiz, a former Peronist Deputy, Hector Sandler, a former independent deputy, Adolfo Gass, ex-Radical party deputy and Radical party ex-Senator, Hipolito Solari Yrigoyen -- are not resident in Argentina nor are they representative of the major Argentine political parties.

With the exception of Solari Yrigoyen, who met with you in June, the members of the group are considered inept (Righi and Sandler were credited with the irresponsible release of all prisoners, including known terrorists, following Campora's 1973 inauguration) or far to the left of the mainstream of their parties (Gass and Diaz Ortiz). None of the five were or are now major figures in the Argentine political world. They cannot be considered as spokesmen of the major parties, whose activities are suspended but whose leaders move freely in and out of Argentina.

I have also received a request from COHA to meet with the five. I intend to have them meet with ARA Deputy Assistant Secretary Frank McNeil, which is in line with our Embassy's advice on this matter (see attached cable).

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COHA originally intended for the Argentines to meet with you in early March; however, because of difficulties in getting the five together in Washington, COHA is now thinking of an early April meeting.

There are strong arguments for not meeting with the five Argentines.

- -- You would give prestige to a group of generally discredited or unrepresentative politicians.
- -- The action might anger the GOA and cause it to hold back on immediate improvements in the human rights field.

On the other hand:

- -- A meeting with the five would underline the Administration's commitment to democratic regimes.
- -- It would give an audience to individuals who have complained of the human rights violations in Argentina.

Recommendation:

That you not meet with the five and that you designate Deputy Assistant Secretary McNeil to meet with them when they formally request an appointment with you.

1. SUMMARY: ACCORDING TO EMBASSY FILES, MOST OF
THE ARGENTINES INVITED TO THE CONA-SPONSORED
CONFERENCE ARE KNOWN TO HAVE BEEN LEFTIST-LEAMING,
BUT FAR FROM SUBVERSIVE. SANTIAGO DIAZ CRITIZ AND
HIFOLITO SOLART TRIGOTEN WERE CLOSELY COMMECTED TO
THE NOW OUTLAWED PERCHIST YOUTH ORGANIZATION;
ESTERAN RIGHT WAS THE RATHER INEFFECTUAL COLLEAGUE
OF HECTOR CAMPORA; HECTOR SANDLER HAS A OUTRKY
CENTER-LEFT POLITICAL PAST, RODLFA GAS IS NOT WELL
KNOWN. SOLARI IRIGOYEN WAS RELEASED FROM PRISON
AND EXPELLED FROM ARGENTINA IN MAY, TETT; SEVERAL
OF THE OTHERS LEFT ARGENTINA BEFORE LIFE PRESENT
MILITARY REGIME TOON POWER. WE DO NOT BELIEVE A
WISIT WITH ASSISTANT SECRETARY TOOMAN WOULD BE
USEFUL AST THIS TIME. END SUMMARY.

2. FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF THE BIO INFORMATION AVAILABLE

CA) HECTOR SANDLER: FORMER SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE UDELPA PARTY DIATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR THE UNION OF THE ARGENTINE PEOPLE), A SELF-DESCRIBED CENTER-LEFT PARTY WHICH WAS FORMER PRESIDENT ARANBURU'S POLITICAL VEHICLE; FORMER NATIONAL DEPUTY WHO WAS KNOWN AS AN ECCENTRIC, ECOCENTRIC AND PROBLEMATIC BUT POLITICALLY SAMAY LEGISLATOR. SANDLER WAS REPORTEDLY ON THE "TRIPLE A DEATH LIST" DURING THE PERONIST ADMINISTRATION AND IS NOW THE EXILE IN MEXICO, WHERE HE IS DIRECTOR OF THE ARGENTINES IN EXILE HEMS-SHEET "TRIBUNA DEMOCRATICA." SANDLER SPOKE AT THE HARKIN-HOGOVERN CONGERSSIONAL CONFERENCE ON HUMAN RIGHTS IN WASKINGTON IN SEPTEMBER, 1977, WHERE HE CRITICIZED THE MILITARY REGIME'S FAILURE TO RETURN THE COUNTRY TO A DEMOCRATIC, ELECTED GOVERNMENT. SANDLER IS A LAUVER AND WAS IN THE AIR FORCE UNTIL 1956 BEFORE ENTERING POLITICS.

(B) SANTIAGO DIAZ ORTIZ: FORMER PERCHIST DEPUTY WITH TIES TO PERCHIST YOUTH, THE GROUP LATER REPUDIATED BY PERCH WHICH PROVIDED CONSIDERABLE HUMBER OF SYMPATHIZERS AND ACTIVISTS TO THE MONTONEROS. DIAZ ORTIZ RESIGNED ALCHG WITH SEVEN OTHER LEFTIST PERCHIST DEPUTIES IN 1974, WHEN PERCH STEPPED UP. ATTACKS AGAINST LEFTIST TERRORISTS AND TRIED TO REFORM THE PENAL CODE TO COMBAT TERRORISM. WE HAVE AN ADDITIONAL NOTATION IN OUR FILES THAT HE WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE "LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE" FOR THE RELEASE OF POLITICAL PRISONERS"—PRESUMABLY DURING HIS PERIOD AS DEPUTY.

IC) ADDITO GASS: FORMER NATIONAL DEPUTY OF THE RADICAL PARTY:

AS VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE CHAMSER OF DEPUTIES: FOREIGN RELATIONS

NW 5705A1TTEORE GAZENOS GASS IS ONE OF THE FOUNDERS OF THE

LAUNCHED IN CARACAS IN AUGUST, 1977, WHICH CALLED FOR THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF DEHOCRATIC PLURALISM IN ARGENTINA. HE IS

ALSO PRESIDENT OF AN "ARGENTINE SOLIDARITY COMMITTEE" SETUP TO OPPOSE THE CURRENT REGINE.

O) ESTEBAN RIGHI: FORMER INTERIOR MINISTER IN HECTOR CAMPORA GOVERNMENT IN 1973; A LEFTIST LAWYER WITH CLOSE THES TO THE CAMPORA FAMILY, RIGHI ASSUMED HIS POST AT AGE 35 AND WAS CONSIDERED TO BE INEXPERIENCED AND EXPENDABLE ISEE PARAGRAPH 3 BELOW) HE LEFT ASSENTINA IN THE FACE OF RISHING RIGHT-WING VIOLENCE IN OCTOBER, 1974 AND SETTLED IN EXILE IN MEXICO. RIGHI HAS WRITTEN FOR HECTOR SANDLER'S EXILE NEWS-SHEET TRIBUNA MENOCRATICA, PUBLISHED IN MEXICO.

CET HIPOLITO SOLARI IRIGOYEN: FORHER SENATOR FOR RADICAL PARTY AND DEFENSE LAWYER WITH STRONG TIES TO LABOR GROUPS, SOLARI IRIGOYEN WAS IDENTIFIED WITH THE LEFT WING OF THE UCR AND WITH THE PERCHIST YOUTH, AND HE SERVED AS DEFENSE LAWYER FOR ACCUSED TERRORISTS. SOLARI IRIGOYEN WAS OBJECT OF SEVERAL TERRORIST (RIGHT-WING?) ATTACKS AND BOMBINGS IN THE PAST; HE WAS ADDUCTED, DISAPPEASED AND LATER REAPPEARED IN CUSTODY OF THE MILITARY GOVERNMENT FROM AUGUST, 1976 TO MAY, 1977 WHEN HE WAS EXPELLED TO VENEZUELA AS RESULT OF STRONG INTERNATIONAL (INCLUDING U.S.) PRESSURE. SOLARI IRIGOYEN WAS

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ACCUSED OF "DEFENDING TERRORISTS" BY THE MILITARY GOVERNMENT BUT HAS A REPUTATION AS A DEDICATED DEMOCRAT AND FIRM BELIEVER IN PEACE AND DUE PROCESS. HE VISITED WITH DEPUTY SECRETARY ASSISTANT SECRETARIES TODMAN AND DERIAN ON VISIT CHRISTOPHER, TO U.S. IN JULY 1977. GOA PROTESTED AGAINST USG OFFICIALS RECEIVING SOLARI IRIGOYEN, WHOM THEY IDENTIFIED AS A "TERRORIST ACCOMPLICE.") SOLARI IRIGOYEN HAS SPOKEN OUT AGAINST THE MILITARY REGIME AND HIS OWN SUFFERINGS IN DETENTION IN EUROPE AND IN SOUTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES. FOR EXAMPLE, HE WAS REPORTED IN PARIS AS SAYING THAT THE FRENCH NUNS WERE KIDNAPPED BY "ARGENTINE PARAMILITARY FORCES" LIKE 15,000 OTHER PRISONERS IN ARGENTINA. IN JULY, 1977, HOWEVER, AT A EUROPEAN LATIN AMERICAN CONFERENCE IN MEXICO HE REFUSED TO SIGN A STATEMENT CONDEMNING ARGENTINA BECAUSE MONTONEROS—WHOM HE REJECTS FOR THEIR VIOLENT PRACTICES AND POLITICAL AIMS--WERE REPRESENTED AT THE MEETING.

3. EMBASSY BELIEVES THAT ASSISTANT SECRETARY TODMAN'S MEETING WITH THIS GROUP WOULD NOT BE WORTH THE BAD FEELING IT WOULD STIR UP WITHIN THE GOA AND AMONG ARGENTINES WHO LOOK BACK WITH DISMAY ON THE COUNTRY'S POLITICAL HISTORY DURING THE TIME THESE MEN WERE PROMINENT. ALSO, WITH THE EXCEPTION DE SULBRITATION OF SULBR TRIGOYEN, WHO HAS BEEN RECEIVED BEFORE AT A HIGH LEVEL IN THE DEPARTMENT, THE OTHER POLITICIANS DO NOT HAVE MUCH OF A POLITICAL FOLLOWING IN ARGENTINA. RIGHT IS REMEMBERED BY OBJECTIVE POLITICAL OBSERVERS AS HAVING BEEN UNWISE, ENOUGH TO ACCEPT THE INTERIOR MINISTRY UNDER CAMPORA AND TO HAVE BEEN INVOLVED, AT LEAST BY HIS ACQUIESCENCE, IN THE FATEFUL DECISION. TO EMPTY THE JAILS OF A LARGE NUMBER OF TERRORISTS ON CAMPORA'S MAUGURAL DAY, RIGHT--WHETHER RIGHTFULLY OR WRONGEULLY--TOOK THE RAP FOR THIS DECISION, WHICH LED TO A WAVE OF TERRORIST BLOODLETTING THE SAME DAY, EVER SINCE USED BY THE ARGENTINE MILITARY AS JUSTIFICATION FOR RESPONDING WITH A COUNTER-TERROR OF THEIR OWN. ALL OF THE FIVE ARE POLITICIANS OF THE LEFT WHO, WHILE CERTAINLY NOT EXTREMISTS THEMSELVES, MAINTAINED, F WHATEVER REASON, CERTAIN POLITICAL CONNECTIONS TO GROUPS WHATEVER REASON, CERTAIN POLITICAL CONNECTIONS TO GROUPS
RECOGNIZED AS ADVOCATES OF VIOLENCE. TO THE CURRENT REGIME AND
A GREAT MANY ARGENTINES THIS IS TANTAMOUNT TO BEING A
SYMPATHIZER OR AGENT OF TERRORISM. SHOULD THESE APPEAR TO BE
IMPERATIVE REASONS THAT THE GROUP BE RECEIVED IN THE DEPARTMENT,
WE RECOMMEND THIS BE ACCOMPLISHED AT LOWER THAN THE ASSISTANT. SECRETARY'S I EVEL: CHAPLIN

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
