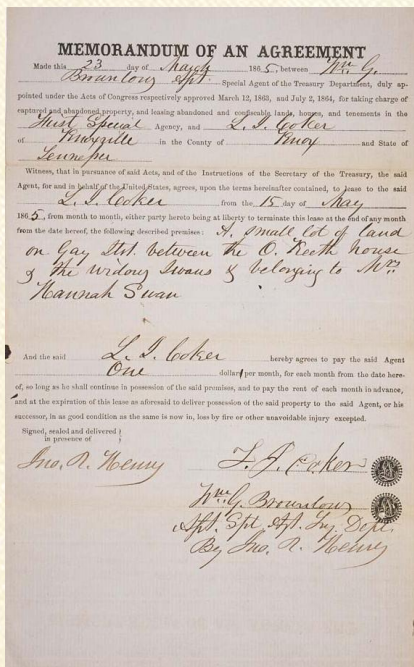
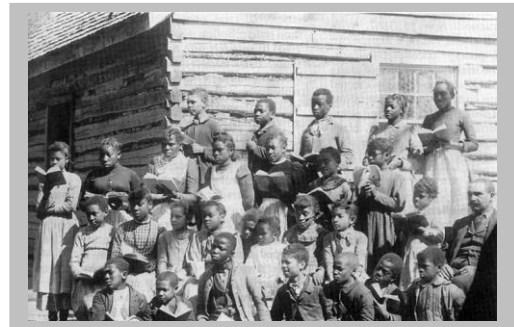


# Back By Popular Demand!
