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

## United States World War I Draft Registration Cards, 1917-1918

### Description

Name index and images of draft registration cards for World War I. Three registrations occurred between 1917 and 1918. The 1st was held 5 Jun 1917 for men ages 21-31. The 2nd was held 5 Jun 1918 for men who turned 21 since the 1st registration. The 3rd started 12 Sep 1918 for men ages 18-45. The collection includes cards for 24 million men. The cards are arranged by state, by city or county, by local draft board, then alphabetical by surname. While images for all draft cards are available in the browse the index is 96% complete. The index is not yet complete for Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Nebraska, Nevada, Ohio, Puerto Rico, Utah, Washington, and Wisconsin. The draft registration cards are part of Record Group 163, Records of the Selective Service System (WWI), 1917-1939, and is National Archives Microfilm publication M1509.



# Census Records

- These are the most heavily used genealogical collection (decennial population, mortality schedules and non-population schedules)
- There is a 72-year restriction on access to census information
- The National Archives has Federal census records *on microfilm* from 1790 to 1940
- NARA does not have state census records
- Records are microfilmed and viewable at NARA offices in:

Washington D.C.


## The Official Federal Land Records Site

Welcome to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), General Land Office (GLO) Records Automation web site. We provide live access to Federal land conveyance records for the Public Land States, including image access to more than five million Federal land title records issued between 1820 and the present. We also have images related to survey plats and field notes, dating back to 1810. Due to organization of documents in the GLO collection, this site **does not** currently contain every Federal title record issued for the Public Land States.



### Land Patents

**Federal Land Patents** offer researchers a source of information on the initial transfer of land titles from the Federal government to individuals. In addition to verifying title transfer, this information will allow the researcher to associate an individual (Patentee, Assignee, Warrantee, Widow, or Heir) with a specific location (Legal Land Description) and time (Issue Date). We have a variety of Land Patents on our site, including Cash Entry, Homestead and Military Warrant patents.



### Survey Plats and Field Notes

**Survey plats** are part of the official record of a cadastral survey. Surveying is the art and science of measuring the land to locate the limits of an owner's interest thereon. A cadastral survey is a survey which creates, marks, defines, retraces or re-establishes the boundaries and subdivisions of Federal Lands of the United States. The survey plat is the graphic drawing of the boundaries involved with a particular survey project, and contains the official acreage to be used in the legal

of the lands directed to be sold at Steubenville by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky River," and of the acts amendatory of the same: **There is granted**, by the United States, unto the said William Mercer the half of<sup>t</sup> lot or section of Land above described: **To have and to hold** the said half of<sup>t</sup> lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said William Mercer his heirs and assigns forever.


