## 1867–1874

### **The National Archives at Boston**

*Holds IRS records from Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, and Vermont.*

### **The National Archives at New York City**

*Holds IRS records from New York, New Jersey, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.*

### **The National Archives at Philadelphia**

*Holds IRS records from Pennsylvania, Delaware, West Virginia, Maryland, and Virginia.*

### **The National Archives at Atlanta**

*Holds IRS records from Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.*

### **The National Archives at Chicago**

*Holds IRS records from Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, and Wisconsin.*

### **The National Archives at Kansas City**

*Holds IRS records from Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, and Nebraska.*

### **The National Archives at Fort Worth**

*Holds IRS records from Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas.*

### **The National Archives at Denver**

*Holds IRS records from Colorado, Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, and Wyoming.*

### **The National Archives at Riverside**

*Holds IRS records from Arizona, southern California, and Nevada (Clark County).*

### **The National Archives at San Francisco**

*Holds IRS records from northern California, Hawaii, Nevada (except Clark County), Guam, Pacific Trust Territory, and American Samoa.*

### **The National Archives at Seattle**

*Holds IRS records from Idaho, Oregon, Alaska, and Washington.*

\* Some states were never microfilmed. In those cases, the earlier (1862–1866) lists are held at the National Archives at Kansas City. The later (1867–1874) lists should still be at the appropriate Research Facility as listed above.
