Significant Events

- **Airliner hijackings**
 - **Two airliners crashed into World Trade Towers (two separate events)**
 - **One aircraft hijacked from Boston**
 - **Airliner crashed xxx,PA**
 - **(80 miles southeast of Pittsburgh)**
 - **Aircraft crashed into Pentagon**
 - **Airliner (AA Flight 77 to LAX) hijacked from Dulles IAP**
 - **62 passengers on board**
- **264 total passengers killed**
- **Unknown killed / wounded in World Trade Towers**
- **Four other hijacked aircraft landed safely**

Operations: Crisis Response Cell Actions Taken

- 1000 - Pentagon evacuated
- 1000 - Joint Staff Crisis Response Cell established
- 1015 - CINCs / Services notified to go to "Force Protection 'Delta'"
- 1033 - SECDEF message (DTG 111453Z Sep 01)
 - Ordered DEFCON 3
- NMCC issued message (DTG 111521Z Sep 01) sent message
 - "Force Protection 'Delta'"
 - Cancel all exercises, specifically GLOBAL GUARDIAN

- 110915L - CIA convened a NOIWON conference
- 110945L - Explosion / event at 5th Corridor, Pentagon
- 111026L - Carbomb reported exploded at State Department
- 111031L - Cancel all exercises, specifically GLOBAL GUARDIAN

National Actions Taken

- **CINCNORAD implemented Emergency Security Control of Air Transport (ESCAT) at 1146 EDT**
 - Authority to direct FAA curtail air traffic
 - Cancelled all flights nationwide
- **CINCNORAD implemented Security Control of Air Traffic and Air Navigation Aids (SCATANA) at 1347 EDT**
 - NAVAIDS are still operational
- **White House evacuated / POTUS off site (currently airborne)**
- **All government buildings, monuments, museums and bridges closed**
- **Presidential Reserve Call-up under consideration**
