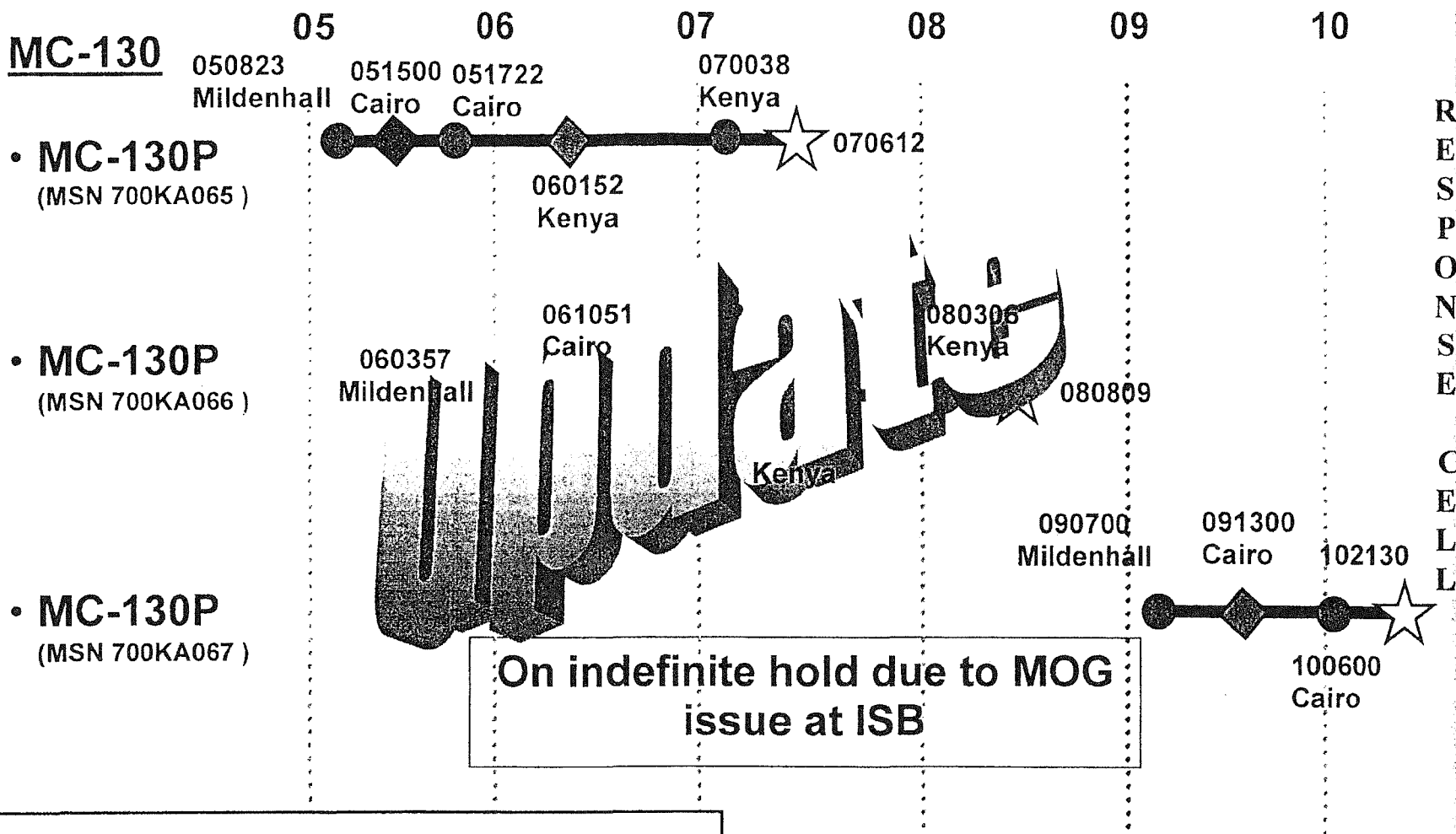

Logistics Flow of Forces



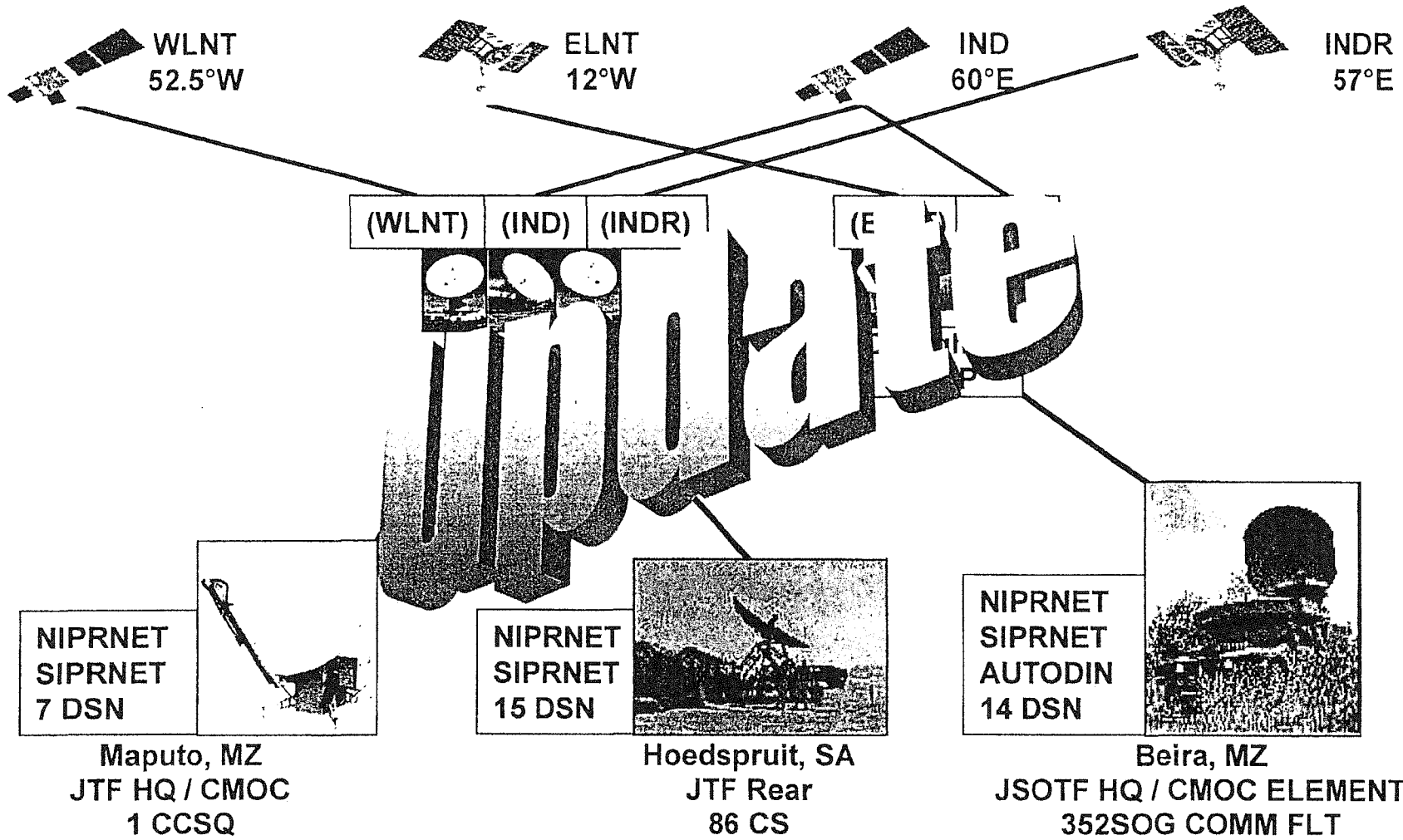
