X SUBJECT: John HENSHAW  
National Enquirer newspaper columnist

X A confidential source of known reliability has advised that John HENSHAW, Washington Bureau Chief for the National Enquirer, a weekly tabloid, and author of the article "Washington Insiders Are Talking About a Fantastic Story Calling Ruby and Oswald Pals," in the 17 May issue of the publication, is known to source.

X Source stated that Henshaw is a close personal associate of Paul Scott, co-writer of the Robert S. Allen-Paul Scott Report, a column published nationally. According to Source, Scott provides the material and leads for Henshaw's columns and frequently writes them for Henshaw. Scott reportedly receives money from Henshaw for this.

Personality-wise, source stated, Henshaw is a weak man, finds it difficult to make decisions, and leans heavily on Scott to put out his column.
