IN LATE OCTOBER 1967 ENIO SILVEIRA, A PROMINENT PUBLISHER AND MEMBER OF THE BRAZILIAN COMMUNIST PARTY WHO RETURNED TO BRAZIL IN MID-OCTOBER FROM A VISIT TO THE SOVIET UNION, SAID THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF THE SOVIET UNION WITH WHOM HE HAD SPOKEN CLAIMED THE CHINESE COMMUNIST GOVERNMENT WAS PLANNING TO CREATE AN INTERNATIONAL INCIDENT WITH THE SOVIET UNION ON THE DATE OF THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SOVIET REVOLUTION.
