Joint Staff Actions

0017-01: Removal of PTDO Strategic Warning in Support of US CENTCOMS CCRF

- **Requestor**: CENTCOM
- **Suspense**: ASAP
- **Action Owned by**: JOD
- **Issues / Background**: Action removes 48 hour strategic warning from the PTDO; commits some of the CCRF to a deployment posture and may force commanders of other CCRF to increase their prepare to deploy postures
- **Recommendation**: Action recommends removing 48 hour strategic warning from the PTDO
- **Status**: From DJS back to the AO for rework of additional issues.

DJS Issues from 150830 Sep 01 Brief

- **Process for FPCON Changes**
 - Stresses Service / unit readiness
 - Feedback indicates threat evaluation of requirements for continuing global FPCON Charlie needed
 - Lay out process for evaluating and changing FPCON to BRAVO
- **Reserve Call-up Mobilization Reporting**
 - Services / CINCs need to track reserve call-up for congressional reporting purposes
- **ROE**
 - Civilian leadership concerned
 - Document Miami airliner incident as textbook example of ROE application

 - Consultation with local authorities - road and facility closure



NORAD/FAA Integration

- Current FAA operations are:
 - Civil/General Aviation ops resumed at 1100L EDT 13 Sep
 - General Aviation ops will be restricted immediately
 - General Aviation ops in Alaska NORAD Region (ANR) are authorized
- Peacetime Op (CONPLAN 3310-96) (Before 11 Sep 01):
 - 4 of 7 available alert bases have 2 fighters on alert 24/7
 - Scramble procedures (C2 and Connectivity) exist from ground scramble to airborne interception





Partial Mobilization of Reserve Components

- Request for Partial Mobilization
 - United States Code Title 10, Section 12302
- Needed to meet expanding Service mission requirements
- Required to support North American Air Defense Contingency Plan 3310 and all active Service Components
- Not to exceed 50,000
 - Army 10,000
 - Navy 3,000
 - Marine Corps 7,500
 - Air Force 13,000
 - Coast Guard 2,000
- POTUS signed Executive Order # 13223 on 14 Sep
- SECDEF has issued authority for recall to Service Secretaries and SECTRANS


