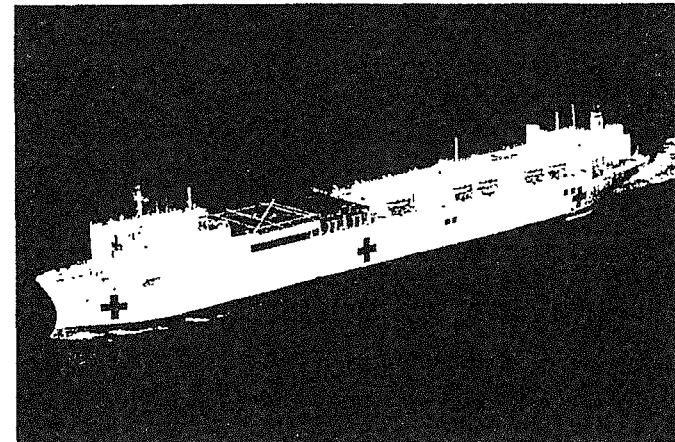

 - Navy: 3,000
 - Marine Corps: 7,500
 - Air Force: 13,000
 - Coast Guard: 2,000

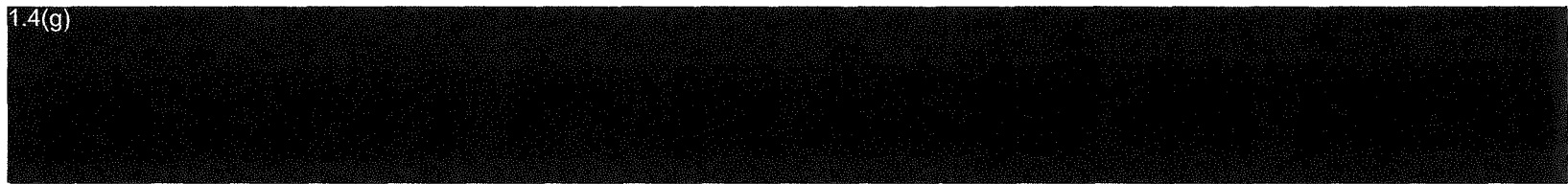

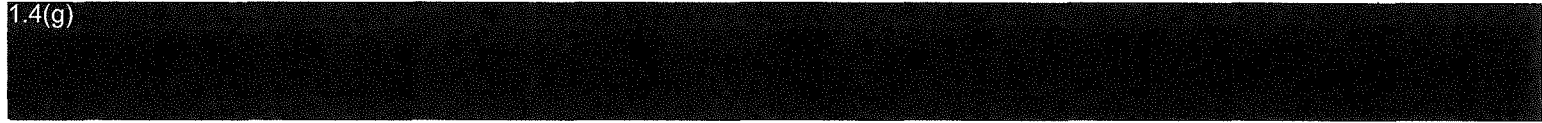

NORAD/FAA Integration

- **Current FAA operations are:**
 - Civil/General Aviation ops resumed at 1100L EDT 13 Sep
 - General Aviation ops will be restricted immediately
 - General Aviation ops in Alaska NORAD Region (ANR) are authorized
- **Peacetime Op (CONPLAN 3310-96) (Before 11 Sep 01):**
 - 4 of 7 available alert bases have 2 fighters on alert 24/7
 - Scramble procedures (C2 and Connectivity) exist from ground scramble to airborne interception

NORAD/FAA Integration Concerns

- Civil Aviation deviates from a flight plan, fighter aircraft scramble from airborne cap, can airspace be deconflicted in a timely manner?- Use existing scramble procedures?
- Military rotary aviation do not file flight plans and are not assigned discrete codes
- How is General Aviation integrated back into the CONUS structure during ^{1.4(g)} [redacted] or return to peacetime ops?

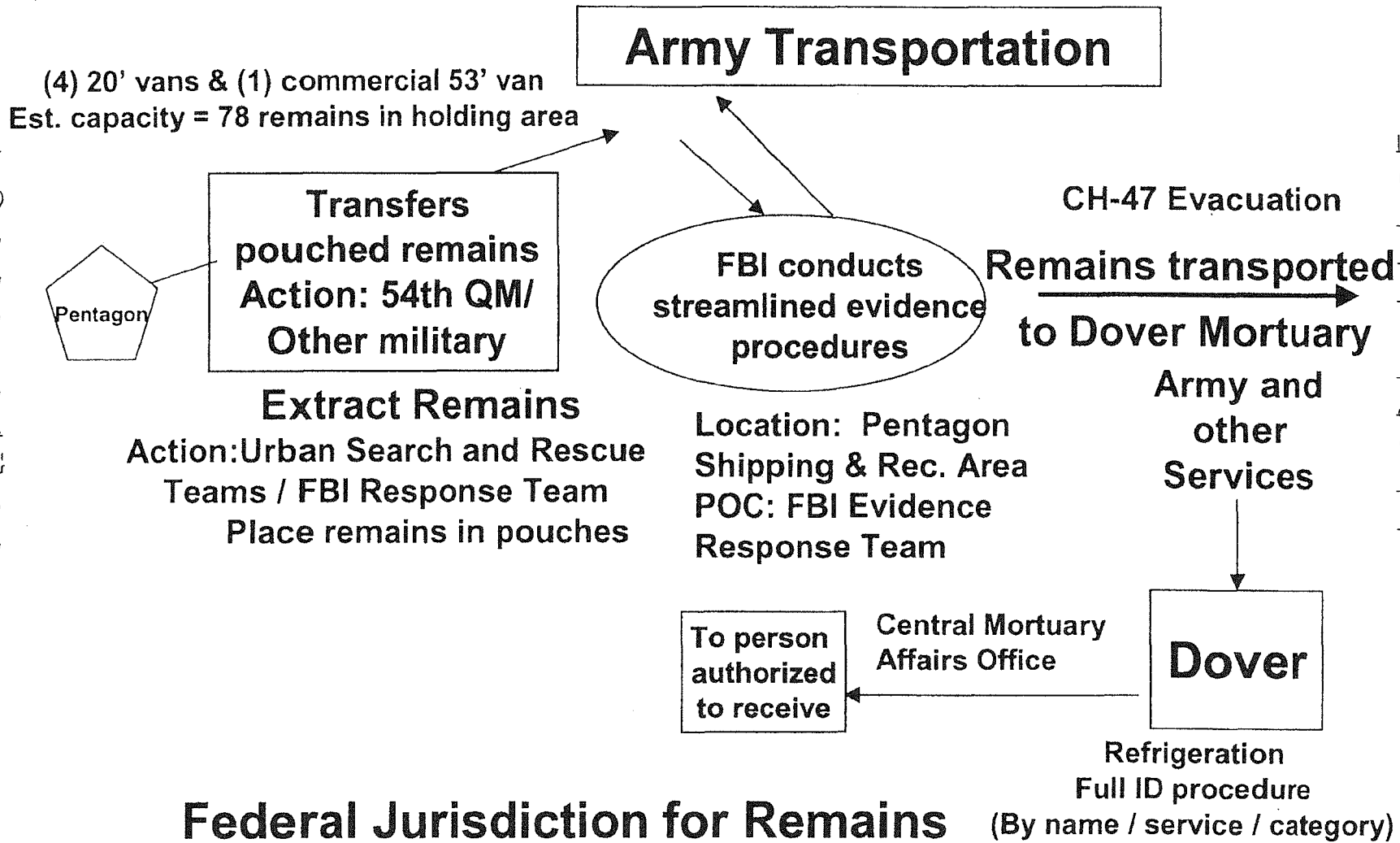

Operation NOBLE EAGLE Summary as of 2000 EDT 14 Sep 01

Force Protection Condition (FPCON):

- **USA/USN//USMC/USAF/USCG/CINCs at 'CHARLIE' except:**
 - **CENTCOM at 'DELTA'**
 - **Local threat intel keeping other sites at DELTA**

Logistics Update:

- 4 USA CH-47D missions airlifting Pentagon remains from Ft Belvoir to Dover AFB scheduled for 15 Sep
- USS Comfort at Pier 92, NYC

Significant Events (Last 24 HRS): (All times local)

- 132202 - USCINCFCOM ADVON element of JTF-CS arrived Stewart ANG Base
- 132220 - CINCNORAD releases USS Constellation back to CINCPACFLEET
- 141310 - JTF-CS ADVON team ordered to re-deploy Ft. Monroe

NORAD Air Defense Posture:

- 1.4(g) **Combat Air Patrol (CAP)**
- 4 fighters/1 tanker over Washington Area
- 2 fighters/1 tanker over NYC
- 1 AWACS controlling both CAPS
- Alert tankers at 10 bases (30 total)
- Alert fighters at 26 bases (104 total)

Pending Actions:

- **Partial Mobilization** not to exceed 50K. Initial Service requests received - USA - 10,000; USAF - 13,000; USN - 3,000, USMC - 7,500, USCG - 2,000 - (POTUS signed), SECDEF to delegate authority to **Service Secretaries**
- **DEPOD for CONUS Air Forces supporting NORAD** - Received new NORAD RFF, Working Changes
- **DoD Linguist support to FBI** -- DepSecDef approved 141855
- **ROE for NORAD/PACOM** -- revised ROE chops with NORAD and PACOM
- **Critical Infrastructure Protection**-- Message sent to CINCS, requesting review of critical asset lists previously submitted
- **Received NORAD Request For Security Forces at U.S. Radar Sites**--Working with FAA/NORAD/OSD
