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Jim-- As discussed, in order to effectuate a near-term enforcement action targeting the Victor Butt Organization (VBO), here are some points transnational would suggest Leon raise with the South African Ambassador this afternoon.

- \* expect MKA to raise tomorrow
- \* although VB expelled from SA in 1998, intel shared with your gov't last week indicates VBO aircraft still transitting SA
- \* understand your prosecutors are looking at possible criminal liability under your anti-mercenary statute (Regulation of Foreign Military Assistance Act)
- \* believe it is important for law enforcement officials to use this statute and to press hard 1.4(c) 1.4(c)
- \* once we have a warrant, we are prepared to urge UAE to transfer custody to SA; have already raised with UAE at high levels
- \* USG ready to provide any requested assistance; prepared to send team in next couple of weeks

Schneidman and I spoke with Deputy PM Pahad this morning and raised the first and last points. As to the 4th point, we indicated that you all would share specific ideas concerning a way forward this afternoon.
