The start of the series had been scheduled for 21 June but was delayed by technical and weather problems. The French have been testing in the atmosphere at their Pacific site since 1966. Although each year the nuclear tests have been accompanied by protests from various countries in the area, France plans to continue nuclear testing at least through 1976. Paris, nevertheless, may decide to move some of its nuclear testing undergound when it determines that such testing could obtain all the desired technical information.
