Dear President Trump:

Your Administration has demonstrated that historically significant records can be reviewed and released in a manner that advances a more transparent and accountable federal record. As the Nation approaches the twenty-fifth anniversary of the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks, there is a unique opportunity to build upon those efforts.

The Board has long advocated for the public release of the 9/11 Commission records. Interest in the broader universe of 9/11-related records continues to grow among Congress and the public, as indicated by an additional congressional request received just last week. While many remaining 9/11 records present complex declassification challenges, the Board believes the following two record sets are of exceptional public interest and present an important opportunity to further transparency through timely review and public release:

- The 9/11 Commission's "PDB Summary and Analysis" concerning pre-September 11 intelligence reporting on al-Qaeda.
- 9/11 Commission Memoranda for the Record of interviews with Condoleezza Rice, Samuel Berger, Richard Clarke, Michael Scheuer, and George Tenet.

While the two record sets identified above present timely opportunities for public release, the Board believes they underscore the value of a broader government-wide review of 9/11-related records. The Board stands ready to support your Administration in advancing this effort, including by providing draft Executive Order language.
