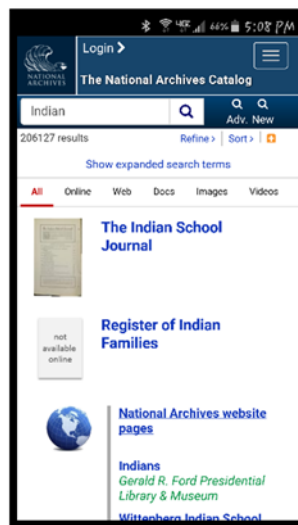


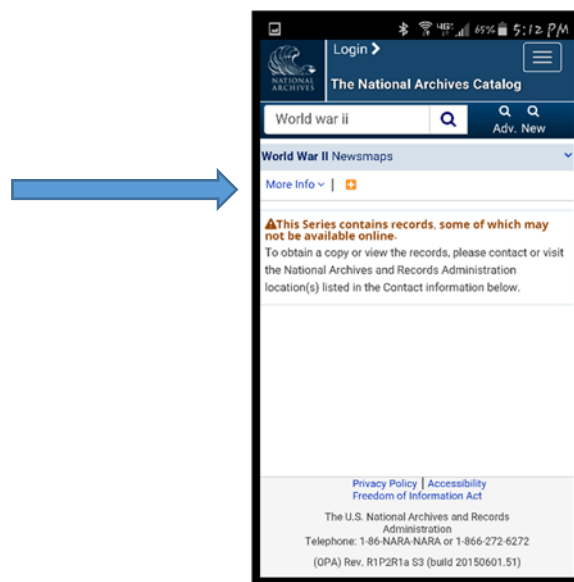
# Tablets and Cell Phones

It has been pointed out to me that the National Archives Online Catalog display is different on cell phones and tablets. I looked at everything I have and I can see this is true. In short, everything inside the Online Catalog is compressed.

- Using your browser, go to [www.archives.gov](http://www.archives.gov)
- Click on Research Our Records
- Click on the Online Catalog
- Conduct your search
- In the Search Results
  - You have to click on the title to see any part of a series, for instance. This means that those necessary date ranges are not visible until you open it. It looks like this on my Android phone.

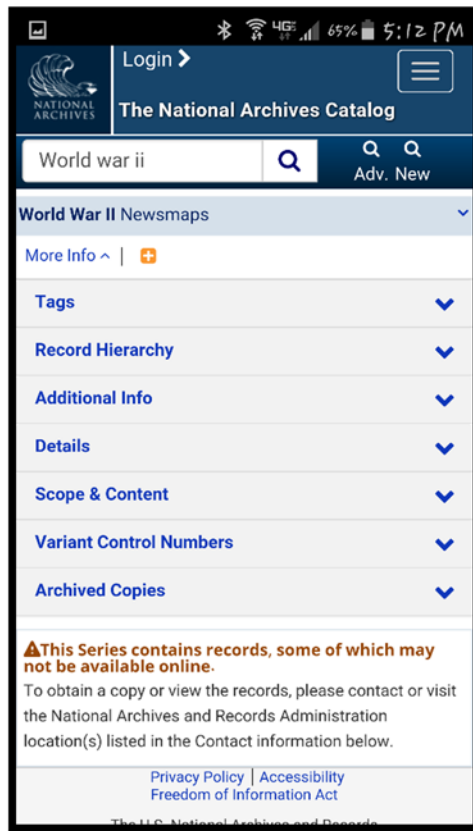


- When you click on an item or description you will see this.



- Now you will have to click on the tiny little "More info" in the upper left.

- Then something like this will appear



- You will need to click on each section to see the details.
