

Fold3

- 2007 NARA and Footnote signed a digitization partnership agreement
- Footnote/Fold3 has digitized over 70 million NARA records
- Fall 2010 Footnote was purchased by Ancestry
- August 17, 2011 Footnote became Fold 3 and changed its focus to military records

Fold3

- Unlike our other partners, Fold3's focus has always been broader than genealogy.
- They have digitized and hosted records for NARA about the Holocaust, Pearl Harbor, and Vietnam that would be of more interest to researchers who are not genealogists.
- There is an abundance of military records that could be digitized. At least half of NARA's records are military records.

Footnote to Fold3

- Fold 3 will continue to host non-military records currently on its site
- If Fold3 decides to stop hosting any NARA content, NARA receives a copy of the content and can use it for its own purposes with no restrictions
