Dear Mr. McGahn:

In accordance with the requirements of the Presidential Records Act (PRA), as amended, 44 U.S.C. §§2201-2209, this letter constitutes a formal notice from the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) to the incumbent President of our intent to open George W. Bush Presidential records in response to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests listed in Attachment A.

This material, consisting of 68,581 pages and 22,837 assets, has been reviewed for the six PRA Presidential restrictive categories, including confidential communications requesting or submitting advice (P5) and material related to appointments to federal office (P2), as they were eased by President George W. Bush on November 15, 2010. These records were also reviewed for all applicable FOIA exemptions. As a result of this review, 37,404 pages and 7,903 assets in whole and 1,043 pages and 502 assets in part have been restricted. Therefore, NARA is proposing to open the remaining 30,134 pages and 14,432 assets in whole and 1,043 pages and 502 assets in part that do not require closure under 44 U.S.C. § 2204. A copy of any records proposed for release under this notice will be provided to you upon your request.

We are also concurrently informing former President George W. Bush's representative, Tobi Young, of our intent to release these records. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. 2208(a), NARA will release the records 60 working days from the date of this letter, which is September 20, 2018, unless the former or incumbent President requests a one-time extension of an additional 30 working days or asserts a constitutionally based privilege, in accordance with 44 U.S.C. 2208(b)-(d). Please let us know if you are able to complete your review before the expiration of the 60 working day period. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. 2208(a)(1)(B), we will make this notice available to the public on the NARA website.

Events from 2009 include the presentation of the United States Mint’s George W. Bush Second Term Medal, President George W. Bush and former President George H.W. Bush participating in an interview with historian Richard Norton Smith, staff preparing the Oval Office and other White House rooms for the new administration, and President George W. A vast majority of the production documents consist of routine email printouts from the Exchange Email system. Also present within the production documents are news articles and press releases, Congressional hearing transcripts, and several letters between White House officials and members of

Congress requesting information about the dismissed United States Attorneys, and correspondence from the Department of Justice describing its response to these requests. Statements and talking points and drafts thereof are included. The majority of these production documents are from the White House Counsel’s Office. Electronic records proposed for opening consist of news articles, press releases, and statements. Additionally, there are emails from United States Attorneys confirming their retirement and emails setting up swearing-in ceremonies for new federal employees. Also, there are letters and reports from the Government Accountability Office regarding federal vacancies and appointments as well as correspondence between White House officials and members of Congress. These electronic records are from the Exchange Email, Exchange Email Restored 40 Days, and RNC Personal Storage Table (PST) Search and Access Sets.

These materials are from the White House Office of Records Management and the Office of Administration. Electronic records proposed for opening consist of fact sheets, talking points, Q&As, scheduling emails, administrative emails regarding USTR personnel, travel vouchers, meeting agendas and reminders, statements, and remarks. Emails relate to lunch meetings, undeliverable message alerts, White House tour requests and information, a Latin American Daily email, the Trade Policy Review Group (TPRG), statements and remarks by U.S. Trade Representative Robert B. Zoellick, and emails regarding Mrs. Cruz's new position at the U.S. Department of the Treasury. Additionally, there are numerous emails regarding the Doha Round negotiations and the President's Economic Forum in Waco, TX, such as talking points, fact sheets, Q&As, remarks, statements, scheduling and meeting information. These records range in date from 2001 to fall 2002 and are from the Automated Records Management System (ARMS) and Exchange Email Search and Access Sets.

Published reports include *The Federal Response to Hurricane Katrina: Lessons Learned* and *National Strategy for Combating Terrorism*. Also included are documents related to the Supreme Court nominations of Harriet Miers, Samuel Alito, and John Roberts, including previous administration documents, publicly released financial disclosures, questionnaires, printed articles, letters of support, news coverage, talking points, fact sheets, and printed legal documents. Some material in this request pre-dates Perino's time in the White House; these items presumably come from Ari Fleischer, Scott McClellan, or Tony Snow. These materials are from the White House Press Office.

In accordance with the requirements of the Presidential Records Act (PRA), as amended, 44 U.S.C. §§2201-2209, this letter constitutes a formal notice from the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) to you, as former President George W. Bush's representative, of our intent to open George W. Bush Presidential records. These records were processed under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests described in Attachment A.

These records, consisting of 68,581 pages and 22,837 assets, have been reviewed for the six PRA Presidential restrictive categories, including confidential communications requesting or submitting advice (P5) and material related to appointments to federal office (P2), as they were eased by President George W. Bush on November 15, 2010. These pages were also reviewed for all applicable FOIA exemptions. As a result of this review, NARA has restricted 37,404 pages and 7,903 assets in whole and 1,043 pages and 502 assets in part. NARA is proposing to open the remaining 30,134 pages and 14,432 assets in whole and 1,043 pages and 502 assets in part that do not require closure under 44 U.S.C. § 2204. A copy of any records proposed for release under this notice will be made available to you upon your request.

We are also concurrently informing the incumbent President of our intent to release these George W. Bush Presidential records. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. 2208(a), NARA will release the records 60 working days from the date of this letter, which is September 20, 2018, unless the former or incumbent President requests a one-time extension of an additional 30 working days or asserts a constitutionally based privilege, in accordance with 44 U.S.C. 2208(b)-(d). Please let us know if you are able to complete your review before the expiration of the 60 working day period. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. 2208(a)(1)(B), we will make this notice available to the public on the NARA website.
