Dear Mr. Warrington:

In accordance with the requirements of the Presidential Records Act (PRA), as amended, 44 U.S.C. §§2201-2209, this letter constitutes a formal notice from the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) to the incumbent President of our intent to open Clinton Presidential records in response to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests listed in Attachment A.

These records, consisting of 12,019 photographs and 19 videotapes have been reviewed for all applicable FOIA exemptions, resulting in 392 photographs restricted. NARA is proposing to open the remaining 11,627 photographs and 19 videotapes. A copy of any records proposed for release under this notice will be provided to you upon your request.

We are also concurrently informing former President Clinton's representative, Bruce Lindsey, of our intent to release these records. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. 2208(a), NARA will release the records 60 working days from the date of this letter, which is October 6, 2026, unless the former or incumbent President requests a one-time extension of an additional 30 working days or asserts a constitutionally based privilege, in accordance with 44 U.S.C. 2208(b)-(d). Please let us know if you are able to complete your review before the expiration of the 60 working day period. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. 2208(a)(1)(B), we will make this notice available to the public on the NARA website.

This researcher submitted a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all White House Television (WHTV) video recordings related to President William Jefferson Clinton's trip to Moscow, Russia on January 13, 1994 through January 15, 1994. The Clinton Presidential Records to be opened include video from January 13, 1994 including an arrival ceremony at the Kremlin in Moscow, Russia, a walking tour of the grounds of the Kremlin, and delivering remarks at Spaso House in Russia. Video from January 14, 1994 includes a press conference with President William Jefferson Clinton & President Boris Yeltsin in Moscow, Russia, an interview with Wolf Blitzer in Moscow, delivering a weekly radio address in Moscow, meeting with President Yeltsin in Moscow, participating in a trilateral signing at Green Hall in the Kremlin, participating in a town hall meeting at the Ostankino Television Station in Moscow, and attending a state dinner in Moscow. Video from January 15, 1994 includes remarks to United States embassy staff in Moscow, Russia, and a departure ceremony along with subsequent departure from Moscow. Individuals at the events include President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, President Boris Nikolayevich Yeltsin (Борис Николаевич Ельцин) of Russia, Anastasia Iosifovna Naina Yeltsina (Анастасия Иосифовна Наина Ельцина), Leonard Makarovych Kravchuk (Леонід Макарович Кравчук) of Ukraine, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Foreign Minister Andrei Vladimirovich Kozurev (Андрей Владимирович Козырев), Ambassador Thomas Pickering, David Gergen, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Ralph Alswang, Wolf Blitzer (Reporter; CNN), along with various individuals involved with both the United States and Russian delegations.

Video containing President Clinton meeting in the Oval Office with President Leonid Kuchma of Ukraine on December 8, 1999 appears on Master Tape 10948. In consequence other events are contained in this videotape. The recordings include: December 6, 1999, Congressional Black Caucus meeting, December 7, 1999, Meeting with NATO Secretary General Lord George Robertson, December 7, 1999, Meeting with Medical Representatives, December 9, 1999, Marine One Departure from the South Lawn, December 9, 1999, Arrival on the South Lawn from Andrews Air Force Base, December 9, 1999, Radio Announcements endorsing Mayor Willie Brown of San Francisco, CA, December 10, 1999, Marine One Departure from the South Lawn. Total run time of the Master Tape 10948 is approximately 25 minutes.
