Dear Mr. Warrington:

In accordance with the requirements of the Presidential Records Act (PRA), as amended, 44 U.S.C. §§ 2201-2209, this letter constitutes a formal notice from the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) to the incumbent President of our intent to release records of the 45th Presidential Administration in response to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests listed in Attachment A.

This material, consisting of 5,798 pages, 2,934 photographs, and 1,045 assets, has been reviewed for the six PRA Presidential restrictive categories, including confidential communications requesting or submitting advice (P5) and material related to appointments to federal office (P2). These records were also reviewed for all applicable FOIA exemptions. As a result of this review, 503 pages, 241 photographs, and 501 assets in whole and 893 pages and 189 assets in part have been restricted. Therefore, NARA is proposing to open the remaining 4,402 pages, 355 assets, and 2,693 photographs in whole and 893 pages and 189 assets in part that do not require closure under 44 U.S.C. § 2204. A copy of any records proposed for release under this notice will be provided to you upon your request.

We are providing this notification to White House Counsel in your role as legal representative for the incumbent and as point of contact for records of the 45th administration. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. § 2208(a), NARA will release any non-privileged, non-exempt records 60 working days from the date of this letter, which is October 19, 2026, unless the former or incumbent President requests a one-time extension of an additional 30 working days or asserts a constitutionally based privilege, in accordance with 44 U.S.C. § 2208(b)-(d). Please let us know if you are able to complete your review before the expiration of the 60 working day period. Pursuant to 44 U.S.C. § 2208(a)(1)(B), we will make this notice available to the public on the NARA website.
