

In Senate of the United States.

The Senate took into consideration the Treaty  
and two Conventions made with the French Republic; —

Whereupon,

Resolved, two thirds of the  
Senators present concurring therein, that the Senate do advise and consent  
to the ratification of the Treaty made and concluded at Paris the 10<sup>th</sup> day  
of Floreal, in the 11<sup>th</sup> year of the French republic, viz. of the 30<sup>th</sup> April, 1803  
between the United States and the said French republic, as well as to the  
two Conventions connected therewith, and made and concluded between the  
two republics, on the same day, by Robert R. Livingston and James  
Munroe, Ministers plenipotentiary on the part of the United States, and  
Barbi Marbois, Minister of the public treasury of the French republic, on  
the part of the said republic. —
