



## **State, Local, Tribal, and Private Sector Policy Advisory Committee (SLTPS-PAC) Public Meeting Report for the 28<sup>th</sup> Meeting**

### **Minutes**

*The meeting was called to order at 10:00 EST*

#### **General Remarks/Updates**

Michael Thomas, SLTPS-PAC Chair, Information Security Oversight Office (ISOO), National Archives and Records Administration (NARA), called the meeting to order.

The SLTPS-PAC charter is up for renewal and will receive due attention from ISOO staff in the coming weeks.

Identifying additional SLTPS members to serve on the committee is another item ISOO would like to see addressed.

Heather Harris Pagán, SLTPS-PAC Designated Federal Officer (DFO), ISOO, NARA, provided administrative updates.

#### **Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Update**

Richard Moreta delivered the update for DHS. DHS is focused on increasing communication and collaboration with all partners over the next year. Much of current DHS guidance, to include Executive Order (EO) 13549, is under review internally and with input from external partners. DHS has an interest in creating SLTPS subcommittees focused on operational topics.

#### **Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) Program Update**

David Means, ISOO, NARA, delivered the update. Entities were reminded of the documents that govern the CUI program, specifically EO 13556 and 32 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR).

Federal agencies are required to provide non-Federal agency partners CUI training on CUI handling requirements, avenues for CUI challenges, mechanisms for reporting misuse of CUI, in addition to clearly identifying what information is considered controlled and requires additional

safeguards. ISOO can connect SLTPS entities with the appropriate CUI Program Manager and answer other CUI-related questions that are not agency-specific.

### **Questions on CUI Program Update**

Margaret Rose, Department of Transportation, asked about the status of an update to EO 13556. ISOO stated that the timeline for an updated version of EO 13556 is unclear. The last Presidential administration convened an interagency policy process to put forth recommendations for revisions to the EO. ISOO is awaiting direction from the current administration on potential CUI reform.

### **General Discussion, Remarks and Adjournment**

The next SLTPS-PAC public meeting is tentatively scheduled for January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at the National Archives in Washington, DC.

Michael Thomas, SLTPS-PAC Chair, ISOO, NARA, closed out the meeting.

Information Security Oversight Office (ISOO)

- Executive Order (EO) 13556
- 32 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 2002
- National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Special Publication (SP) 800-171, Rev. 3
- NIST SP 800-171A, Rev. 3

- Not classified information
- Information Government creates or possesses, or
- Information an entity creates or possess *on behalf of* the Government
- Requires safeguarding and/or dissemination controls
- In accordance with a Law, Regulation or Government-Wide Policy

Federal *agency* guidance includes:

- Training
- Identification of *specific* information as CUI
- Handling requirements
- Process for CUI challenges
- Process for reporting misuse of CUI
