1929	* Note: the U.S. had avoided involvement in European wars until 1917 when it entered World War I. After World War I, the U.S. adopted policies that, again, distanced America from military commitments in European affairs. During the 1930's, however, the rise of aggressive powers such as Germany and Italy in Europe and Japan in Asia triggered the outbreak of World War II. The U.S. was thrust into the war after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor in 1941. After the war, the U.S. sponsored the creation of the United Nations – headquartered in the U.S. – to help prevent future wars. And, in 1949, the U.S. formed NATO (the North Atlantic Treaty Organization) to oppose the now aggressive Soviet Union.  The origins of World War II can be traced to Japan's attacks on China that began in 1931. The war started in Europe in 1939 when Nazi Germany invaded Poland. The U.S. avoided direct military involvement in the war until 1941.
