SUBJECT: Allegation of Abuses
By Purported CIA Agent

Arthur K. Snyder, a member of the Los Angeles City Council, has written the President to complain of the actions of

[REDACTED] in Los Angeles. According to Snyder, **[REDACTED]** has been identifying himself as a CIA agent and using that status to influence reporters and affect local politics. Snyder offered to talk with investigators about the matter, and introduce them to others familiar with **[REDACTED]** alleged abuses.
