- September 14 **Finding Family: Introduction to Genealogy**
Archives staff present a lecture on basic genealogical research in Federal records and how to get started with your own family history research. This program runs from 12:30pm-1:30pm.
- October 12 **Finding Family: Genealogy Open House**

Archives staff will demonstrate how to search NARA's microfilm collection online, using our "Order Online" system as well as researching actual microfilm holdings via our partner subscription services such as *Ancestry* and *Footnote*. This program runs from 12:30pm-1:30pm.
